Basic school regulation for preschool, elementary and secondary education —Amendment

Regulation to amend the Basic school regulation for preschool, elementary and secondary education

WHEREAS, under section 447 of the Education Act (chapter I-13.3), the Government may make regulations to be known as the "basic school regulation";

WHEREAS the Government made the Basic school regulation for preschool, elementary and secondary education (chapter I-13.3, r. 8);

WHEREAS, in accordance with sections 10 to 13 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1), a draft Regulation to amend the Basic school regulation for preschool, elementary and secondary education was published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* of 2 March 2017 with a notice that it could be made by the Government on the expiry of 20 days following that publication;

WHEREAS, in accordance with section 458 of the Education Act, the draft Regulation was submitted to the Conseil supérieur de l'éducation for preliminary examination;

WHEREAS it is expedient to make the Regulation without amendment;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Education, Recreation and Sports:

THAT the Regulation to amend the Basic school regulation for preschool, elementary and secondary education, attached to this Order in Council, be made.

Regulation to amend the Basic school regulation for preschool, elementary and secondary education

Education Act (chapter I-13.3, s. 447)

1. The Basic school regulation for preschool, elementary and secondary education (chapter I-13.3, r. 8) is amended in section 23.1 by replacing the tables in the second paragraph by the following:

"(5) 4 credits in Secondary IV history;".

3. For the purposes of section 32, as amended by section 2 of this Regulation, a student who has earned 4 credits in Secondary IV history and citizenship education is deemed to have earned 4 credits in Secondary IV history.

4. This Regulation comes into force on 1 July 2017.
