An Act respecting land use planning and development (chapter A-19.1)

Draft Order relating to the declaration of a special planning zone in the territory of certain local municipalities affected by the floods that occurred in April and May 2017 and exemption of the territory contemplated in the draft Order from the prohibitions following its publication

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with section 158 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (chapter A-19.1), that the Government is to declare part of the territory of certain local municipalities a special planning zone by order appearing below;

Under section 161 of the Act, a special planning zone order may be passed only if a draft order has been previously published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.

Under section 163 of the Act, before the adoption of the order, the Minister or the Minister's representative must hold a consultation on the content of the draft order.

Notice is also hereby given, in accordance with section 162 of the Act respecting land use planning and development, that the Government, by Order 594-2017 of 21 June 2017, exempts the overall territory contemplated in the draft Order from the prohibitions provided for in that section.

The prohibitions do not apply to the overall territory contemplated in the draft Order from the publication of this notice in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.

Draft Order

An Act respecting land use planning and development (chapter A-19.1)

Declaration of a special planning zone in the territory of certain local municipalities affected by the floods that occurred in April and May 2017

WHEREAS, under sections 158 and 159 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (chapter A-19.1), the Government may, by order, declare any part of the territory of Québec to be a special planning zone for the purpose of solving a development or environmental problem whose urgency or seriousness, in the opinion of the Government, warrants its intervention;

WHEREAS in April and May 2017, an exceptional spring flood caused major floods in the territory of a number of local municipalities;

WHEREAS the floods caused major damages to a number of residences and other buildings for which repair and reconstruction work is considered;

WHEREAS it is important that work in flood zones be carried out in accordance with the prescriptive framework described in the Protection Policy for Lakeshores, Riverbanks, Littoral Zones and Floodplains (chapter Q-2, r. 35);

WHEREAS it may be timely to allow the reconstruction of certain buildings on certain conditions;

WHEREAS the Government is of the opinion that in that case it is a land use planning problem whose seriousness warrants its intervention;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Land Occupancy:

THAT the part of the territory of the local municipalities listed in Schedule 1 be declared a special planning zone

 located in the high-velocity zone of a floodplain, as delimited in the land use planning and development plan of the regional county municipalities comprising the territory of the municipalities; (2) located in a floodplain identified in the land use planning and development plan of the regional county municipalities without distinguishing the high-velocity zones from the low-velocity zones;

THAT the following objectives be pursued:

(1) ensure the application of the Protection Policy for Lakeshores, Riverbanks, Littoral Zones and Floodplains;

(2) manage adequately flood risks in a context of climate change, particularly by reducing the number of persons and property exposed to future floods;

(3) allow, in certain exceptional circumstances and on certain conditions, the reconstruction of destroyed or severely damaged buildings;

(4) ensure that all the municipalities and persons affected by the floods are subject to consistent standards, made by this Order;

THAT the terms "littoral", "high-velocity zone", "low-velocity zone" and "floodplain" have, in this Order, the meaning attributed to them in the Protection Policy for Lakeshores, Riverbanks, Littoral Zones and Floodplains;

THAT the following land use planning and development controls apply within the perimeter of the special planning zone:

(1) on the littoral, all structures, undertakings and works are prohibited, except the interventions provided for in section 3.3 of the Protection Policy for Lakeshores, Riverbanks, Littoral Zones and Floodplains;

(2) in the high-velocity zone of a floodplain, and in the floodplains identified without distinguishing the highvelocity zones from the low-velocity zones, all structures, including the reconstruction of undertakings or structures destroyed by a flood, all undertakings and works are prohibited, excluding the interventions provided for in sections 4.2.1 and 4.2.2 of the Protection Policy for Lakeshores, Riverbanks, Littoral Zones and Floodplains and those authorized by a municipality in compliance with paragraphs 6 to 9 of this operating part; (3) structures, undertakings and works that are not prohibited under paragraphs 1 and 2 must comply with the flood-proofing standards provided for in Annex 1 to the Protection Policy for Lakeshores, Riverbanks, Littoral Zones and Floodplains;

(4) for the purposes of this Order, including the parts of the Protection Policy for Lakeshores, Riverbanks, Littoral Zones and Floodplains that are applicable by reference, reconstruction consists in repair work the cost of which represents more than half the value of the building as entered in the property assessment roll and repair consists in other repair work;

(5) no private undertaking or structure may be repaired or reconstructed unless its condition has been the subject of an assessment by a claims adjuster or by a person designated by the Minister of Public Security; the authority responsible for authorizing the work related to the repair or reconstruction of that undertaking or structure is bound by the opinion of that person regarding the repair work required;

(6) a municipality may, in exceptional cases and notwithstanding any provision of this Order, authorize, on the conditions determined by the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Land Occupancy,

(a) the reconstruction of a principal residence whose repair costs represent between 50% and 65% of the value of the building as entered in the property assessment roll;

(b) all other undertakings or structures and all other work, excluding residential buildings or work on such a building;

(7) for the purposes of paragraph 6, a municipality must apply for an exemption to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Land Occupancy who must consult the Minister of Sustainable Development, the Environment and the Fight Against Climate Change before ruling on the municipality's application;

(8) where the Minister of Sustainable Development, the Environment and the Fight Against Climate Change is consulted under paragraph 7, the Minister sets up a committee of independent experts in the field of water management, environment and land development to obtain a recommendation from the committee on the processing of the application submitted and on the conditions that must be complied with if the recommendation is favorable; the Minister of Sustainable Development, the Environment and the Fight Against Climate Change sends such recommendation to the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Land Occupancy who must follow up and inform the municipality concerned, by including the applicable conditions if the application is accepted;

(9) to make its recommendation, the committee of independent experts set up under paragraph 8 must take into account

(a) the exceptional nature of the application;

(b) the impact of the exemption on the objectives of the Protection Policy for Lakeshores, Riverbanks, Littoral Zones and Floodplains;

(c) any other criterion determined by the Minister of Sustainable Development, the Environment and the Fight Against Climate Change;

THAT the municipal land use planning and development by-laws not incompatible with the controls provided for in this Order remain applicable within the perimeter of the special planning zone;

THAT the land use planning and development controls provided for in this Order may be amended or revoked by order of the Government published in the *Gazette Officielle du Québec*;

THAT the land use planning and development controls provided for in this Order cease to have effect 18 months after their coming into force;

THAT each local municipality listed in Schedule 1 be designated as the authority responsible for the administration of the controls with respect to part of their respective territory within the perimeter of the special planning zone;

THAT each local municipality listed in Schedule 1 must provide to the Minister of Sustainable Development, the Environment and the Fight Against Climate Change, not later than 60 days after the date on which the land use planning and development controls provided for in this Order cease to have effect, a report of its administration, which must describe, since the coming into force of this Order and for the perimeter of the special planning zone, the building and subdivision permits issued, the inspections carried out and the contraventions to the planning controls provided for in this Order.

O.C. 594-2017, 21 June 2017

An Act respecting land use planning and development (chapter A-19.1)

Exemption of the territory contemplated in the draft Order relating to the declaration of a special planning zone in the territory of certain local municipalities affected by the floods that occurred in April and May 2017 from the prohibitions following the publication of the draft Order

WHEREAS, under sections 158 and 159 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (chapter A-19.1), the Government may, by order, declare any part of the territory of Québec to be a special planning zone for the purpose of solving a development or environmental problem whose urgency or seriousness, in the opinion of the Government, warrants its intervention;

WHEREAS in April and May 2017, an exceptional spring flood caused major floods in the territory of a number of local municipalities;

WHEREAS the floods caused major damages to a number of residences and other buildings;

WHEREAS the Government is of the opinion that there is a land use planning problem whose seriousness warrants its intervention;

WHEREAS the Government wishes to publish in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* a draft Order relating to the declaration of a special planning zone in the territory of certain of those local municipalities, in accordance with section 161 of the Act respecting land use planning and development;

WHEREAS, under the first paragraph of section 162 of the Act respecting land use planning and development, from the date of the publication until the coming into force of the Order, any new construction, alteration, addition or installation is prohibited in the territory contemplated in the draft order, namely the part of the territory of the municipalities listed in Schedule 1 to the draft Order that (1) is located in the high-velocity zone of a floodplain, as delimited in the land use planning and development plan of the regional county municipalities comprising the territory of the municipalities;

(2) is located in a floodplain identified in the land use planning and development plan of the regional county municipalities without distinguishing the high-velocity zones from the low-velocity zones;

WHEREAS, under the second paragraph of section 162 of the Act, the Government may at any time exempt any part of the territory contemplated in the draft Order from the prohibitions enacted by the section and the prohibitions then cease to apply in that part of the territory from the date of the publication by the Minister, in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*, of a notice containing the description of that part of the territory thus exempted from the prohibitions enacted by the section;

WHEREAS it is expedient to exempt the overall territory contemplated in the draft Order from the prohibitions provided for in section 162 of the Act respecting land use planning and development;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Land Occupancy:

THAT the overall territory contemplated by the draft Order relating to the declaration of a special planning zone in the territory of certain local municipalities affected by the floods that occurred in April and May 2017 be exempted from the prohibitions provided for in section 162 of the Act respecting land use planning and development (chapter A-19.1).
