Order number 2019-008 of the Minister of Forests, Wildlife and Parks dated 27 August 2019

An Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1)

CONCERNING the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting hunting

THE MINISTER OF FORESTS, WILDLIFE AND PARKS,

CONSIDERING the second paragraph of section 56 of the Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1), which provides that the Minister may, by regulation, allow the hunting of any animal or any animal of a class of animals determined by the Minister;

CONSIDERING subparagraphs 1 to 3 of the third paragraph of section 56 of the Act, which provide that the regulation may also determine, on the basis of sex or age, what animal or animal of a class of animals may be hunted, the period of the year, day or night during which the animal may be hunted or trapped and the area, territory or place in which the animal may be hunted or trapped;

CONSIDERING subparagraph 3 of the first paragraph of section 163 of the Act, which provides that the Minister may make regulations establishing the requirements that a holder of a licence, certificate, authorization or lease must satisfy;

CONSIDERING the first paragraph of section 164 of the Act, which provides that a regulation made under section 56 or under any of subparagraphs 1 to 3 of the first paragraph of section 163 is not subject to the publication requirements set out in section 8 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1);

CONSIDERING the making of the Regulation respecting hunting (chapter C-61.1, r. 12);

CONSIDERING that it is expedient to amend certain provisions of the Regulation;

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

The Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting hunting, attached hereto, is hereby made.

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting hunting

An Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1, s. 56, 2nd par., 3rd par., subpars. 1 to 3, and s. 163, 1st par., subpar. 3)

1. The Regulation respecting hunting (chapter C-61.1, r. 12) is amended in section 13.9

(1) by inserting the following after subparagraph 3 of the third paragraph:

“(4) is accompanied by a resident holding a moose hunting licence, valid or having expired, if issued in the latter case between 1 April and 31 March of the current year. For the purposes of this subparagraph, the resident may accompany only one licence holder per year;

(5) the holder or an immediate family member holds a right of ownership on an immovable entered on the property assessment roll of a municipality of Québec and hunts moose within the limits of the immovable.”;

(2) by replacing “subparagraph 3” in the fourth paragraph by “subparagraphs 3 and 5”.

2. Section 17 is amended in the first paragraph

(1) by striking out “3 and” in subparagraph 1;

(2) by striking out “3 and” in subparagraph 2;

(3) by inserting the following after subparagraph 5:

“(5.1) in areas 3 and 4, only the hunting of moose with antlers is permitted from 2019 to 2021;”;

(4) by striking out “, 4” in subparagraph 7.

3. Section 3 of Schedule III is amended

(1) by inserting the following after subparagraph *b* of column III of paragraph 1:

“(c) territories of the following municipalities: Notre-Dame-de-Bonsecours, Notre-Dame-de-la-Paix, Fassett, Namur, Saint-Émile-de-Suffolk, Boileau, Grenville, Grenville-sur-la-Rouge, Amherst, Huberdeau, Arundel, Barkmere, Montcalm, Lac-des-Seize-Îles, WentworthNord, Brownsburg-Chatham, Harrington”;

(2) by inserting the following after subparagraph *b* of column IV of paragraph 1:

“(c) from the Saturday on or closest to 22 September to the Sunday on or closest to 16 November”;

(3) by inserting “and except the municipal territories listed in subparagraph *c* of column III of paragraph 1 of section 3 of this Schedule that are part of the area” after “XXIX in subparagraph *b* of column III of paragraph 2”;

(4) by inserting “and except the municipal territories listed in subparagraph *c* of column III of paragraph 1 of section 3 of this Schedule that are part of the area” after “XX in subparagraph *e* of column III of paragraph 3”.

4. Section 4 of Schedule III is amended

(1) by inserting “and except the municipal territories listed in subparagraph *c* of column III of paragraph 1 of section 3 of this Schedule that are part of the area” after “XXII” in subparagraph *b* of column III of paragraph 1;

(2) by inserting “and except the municipal territories listed in subparagraph *c* of column III of paragraph 1 of section 3 of this Schedule that are part of the area” after “XXI” in subparagraph *c* of column III of paragraph 1;

(3) by inserting “and except the municipal territories listed in subparagraph *c* of column III of paragraph 1 of section 3 of this Schedule that are part of the area” after “XXII” in subparagraph *b* of column III of paragraph 2;

(4) by inserting “and except the municipal territories listed in subparagraph *c* of column III of paragraph 1 of section 3 of this Schedule that are part of the area” after “XXI” in subparagraph *e* of column III of paragraph 3;

(5) by inserting “and except the municipal territories listed in subparagraph *c* of column III of paragraph 1 of section 3 of this Schedule that are part of the area” after “XXII” in subparagraph *i* of column III of paragraph 3.

5. This Regulation comes into force on 17 September 2019.
