#### **O.C. 704-2020**, 30 June 2020

An Act to facilitate the payment of support (chapter P-2.2)

#### Collection of support —Amendment

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the collection of support

WHEREAS, under the first paragraph of section 35 of the Act to facilitate the payment of support (chapter P-2.2), the Government may impose, in the cases and on the conditions prescribed by regulation, the payment of a fee for the collection of arrears in support payments owed by the debtor of support or of any amount exigible from another person under that Act;

WHEREAS, under paragraph 3 of section 71 of that Act, the Government may determine, by regulation, the cases and conditions in and on which the Government may impose a fee under section 35 of that Act and fix the amount of such fee;

WHEREAS, under paragraph 1 of section 4 of the Regulation respecting the collection of support (chapter P-2.2, r. 1), the fees exigible where an amount whose payment is requested in a demand for payment under the first paragraph of section 46 of the Act to facilitate the payment of support has not been paid within the period prescribed in that section are \$110;

WHEREAS, by Order in Council 177-2020 dated 13 March 2020, the Government declared a public health emergency and took certain measures to protect the health of the population;

WHEREAS, under section 12 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1), a proposed regulation may be made without having been published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* as provided for in section 8 of that Act, if the authority making it is of the opinion that the urgency of the situation requires it;

WHEREAS, under section 13 of that Act, the reason justifying the absence of such publication shall be published with the regulation; WHEREAS, under section 18 of that Act, a regulation may come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* where the authority that has made it is of the opinion that the urgency of the situation requires it;

WHEREAS the Government is of the opinion that the urgency due to the following circumstances justifies the absence of prior publication and such coming into force of the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the collection of support:

—the current COVID-19 pandemic has led to the application of public health measures that have had exceptional economic consequences for debtors and creditors of support;

—it is necessary to provide for the suspension of the requirement to pay fees for debtors and creditors of support where an amount whose payment is requested in a demand for payment under the first paragraph of section 46 of the Act to facilitate the payment of support has not been paid in the time prescribed by that section;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Finance:

THAT the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the collection of support, attached to this Order in Council, be made.

# Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the collection of support

An Act to facilitate the payment of support (chapter P-2.2, s. 71, par. 3)

**I.** The Regulation respecting the collection of support (chapter P-2.2, r. 1), amended by the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the collection of support enacted by Order in Council 443-2020 dated 8 April 2020, is further amended by inserting the following after section 4.1, as made by the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the collection of support:

"4.2. For the period beginning on 2 July 2020 and ending on 30 September 2020, section 4 must read without taking into account its paragraph 1 where a demand for payment has been transmitted to a debtor of support or creditor of support.".

**2.** This Regulation comes into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.

#### **O.C. 690-2020**, 30 June 2020

Renewal of the public health emergency pursuant to section 119 of the Public Health Act

WHEREAS the World Health Organization declared COVID-19 to be a pandemic on 11 March 2020;

WHEREAS, under section 118 of the Public Health Act (chapter S-2.2), the Government may declare a public health emergency in all or part of the territory of Québec where a serious threat to the health of the population, whether real or imminent, requires the immediate application of certain measures provided for in section 123 of the Act to protect the health of the population;

WHEREAS the pandemic constitutes a serious and real threat to the health of the population that requires the immediate application of certain measures provided for in section 123 of the Act;

WHEREAS, under the first paragraph of section 119 of the Act, the public health emergency declared by the Government is effective for a maximum period of ten days at the expiry of which it may be renewed, as many times as necessary, for a maximum period of ten days or, with the consent of the National Assembly, for a maximum period of 30 days;

WHEREAS, under section 121 of the Act, the public health emergency is effective as soon as it is declared or renewed;

WHEREAS, while the public health emergency is in effect, despite any provision to the contrary, the Government or the Minister of Health and Social Services, if the Minister has been so empowered, may, without delay and without further formality, take any of the measures provided for in subparagraphs 1 to 8 of the first paragraph of section 123 of the Act to protect the health of the population;

WHEREAS, by Order in Council 177-2020 dated 13 March 2020, the Government declared a public health emergency and took certain measures to protect the health of the population;

WHEREAS the current situation of the COVID-19 pandemic allows for the easing of certain measures set in place to protect the health of the population, while maintaining some of the measures necessary to continue that protection; IT IS ORDERED, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Health and Social Services:

THAT the suspension of educational and instructional services provided by educational institutions under Order in Council 177-2020 dated 13 March 2020, amended by Orders in Council 505-2020 dated 6 May 2020, 540-2020 dated 20 May 2020, 566-2020 dated 27 May 2020, 588-2020 dated 3 June 2020, 615-2020 dated 10 June 2020 and 651-2020 dated 17 June 2020, be lifted with respect to

(1) the organizing of summer school for students at the Secondary IV and V levels;

(2) the carrying out of local examinations and other local modalities of evaluation for obtaining credits at the Secondary IV and V levels;

Public Health Act (chapter S-2.2)

Ordering of measures to protect the health of the population amid the COVID-19 pandemic situation

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND SOCIAL SERVICES,

CONSIDERING section 118 of the Public Health Act (chapter S-2.2), which provides that the Government may declare a public health emergency in all or part of the territory of Québec where a serious threat to the health of the population, whether real or imminent, requires the immediate application of certain measures provided for in section 123 of the Act to protect the health of the population;

CONSIDERING Order in Council 177-2020 dated 13 March 2020 declaring a public health emergency throughout Québec for a period of 10 days;

CONSIDERING that that Order in Council orders in particular the suspension of the activities of childcare centres, day care centres and home childcare services;

Considering that the public health emergency was renewed until 29 March 2020 by Order in Council 222-2020 dated 20 March 2020, until 7 April 2020 by Order in Council 388-2020 dated 29 March 2020, until 16 April 2020 by Order in Council 418-2020 dated 7 April 2020, until 24 April 2020 by Order in Council 460-2020 dated 15 April 2020, until 29 April 2020 by Order in Council 478-2020 dated 22 April 2020, until 6 May 2020 by Order in Council 483-2020 dated 29 April 2020, until 13 May 2020 by Order in Council 501-2020 dated 6 May 2020, until 20 May 2020 by Order in Council 509-2020 dated 13 May 2020, until 27 May 2020 by Order in Council 531-2020 dated 20 May 2020, until 3 June 2020 by Order in Council 544-2020 dated 27 May 2020, until 10 June 2020 by Order in Council 572-2020 dated 3 June 2020, until 17 June 2020 by Order in Council 593-2020 dated 10 June 2020, until 23 June 2020 by Order in Council 630-2020 dated 17 June 2020 and until 30 June 2020 by Order in Council 667-2020 dated 23 June 2020;

Considering that, by Orders in Council 500-2020 dated 1 May 2020 and 566-2020 dated 27 May 2020, the suspension applicable to the activities of childcare centres, day care centres and home child-care services under Order in Council 177-2020 dated 13 March 2020 was lifted throughout Québec, provided that the activities are carried on in compliance with the conditions set out in the Schedule to Order in Council 505-2020 dated 6 May 2020, amended by Order in Council 566-2020 dated 27 May 2020, and by Ministerial Orders 2020-034 dated 9 May 2020, 2020-039 dated 22 May 2020, 2020-042 dated 12 June 2020 and 2020-047 dated 19 June 2020;

CONSIDERING that Order in Council 505-2020 dated 6 May 2020 empowers the Minister of Health and Social Services to order any modification or clarification of the measures provided for in the Order in Council;

CONSIDERING that Order in Council 667-2020 dated 23 June 2020 empowers the Minister of Health and Social Services to take any measure provided for in subparagraphs 1 to 8 of the first paragraph of section 123 of the Public Health Act;

CONSIDERING that the current situation of the COVID-19 pandemic allows for the easing of certain measures set in place to protect the health of the population, while maintaining some of the measures necessary to continue that protection;

#### ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

THAT the Schedule to Order in Council 505-2020 dated 6 May 2020, amended by Order in Council 566-2020 dated 27 May 2020, and by Ministerial Orders 2020-034 dated 9 May 2020, 2020-039 dated 22 May 2020, 2020-042 dated 4 June 2020, 2020-044 dated 12 June 2020 and 2020-047 dated 19 June 2020, be further amended

(1) by replacing "50%" in section 1 by "75%";

(2) by replacing "4 children, whether the provider is assisted or not" in section 2 by "5 children, or if the provider is assisted, up to 7 children";

(3) by replacing "4 children" in section 6 by "5 children";

THAT this Ministerial Order take effect on 29 June 2020.
