Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the signing of certain acts, documents or writings by members of the personnel of the Conseil du trésor assigned to government services

WHEREAS under section 8 of the Act respecting government services to departments and public bodies (R.S.Q., c. S-6.1), no act, document or writing is binding on the Minister or may be attributed to him unless it is signed by him, by the Deputy Minister of the department or the chief executive officer of the body designated under section 6 or by a member of the personnel of the department or body and, in the case of such a member, only to the extent determined by regulation of the Government published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*;

WHEREAS under section 28 of that Act, no act, document or writing is binding on the Official Publisher or may be attributed to him unless it is signed by him or by a member of the personnel of the department or body designated under section 6 and, in the case of such a member, only to the extent determined by regulation of the Government published in the *Gazette officielle du Ouébec*;

WHEREAS the Regulation respecting the signing of certain acts, documents or writings by members of the personnel of the Conseil du trésor assigned to government services was made by Order in Council 1433-94 dated 7 September 1994;

WHEREAS under Order in Council 1171-94 dated 3 August 1994, made under section 6 of the Act respecting government services to departments and public bodies, the Conseil du trésor was designated as the public body required to place members of its personnel at the disposal of the Minister responsible for that Act;

WHEREAS under Order in Council 1128-96 dated 11 September 1996, made under section 6 of the Act respecting government services to departments and public bodies and amending Order in Council 1171-94 dated 3 August 1994, the ministère des Relations avec les citoyens et de l'Immigration was designated as the department required to place members of its personnel at the disposal of the Minister responsible for functions respecting government information;

WHEREAS it is expedient, in consequence of the foregoing, to amend the Regulation respecting the signing of certain acts, documents or writings by members of the personnel of the Conseil du trésor assigned to government services;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, upon the recommendation of the Minister for Administration and the Public Service and Chairman of the Conseil du trésor, of the Minister of Relations with the Citizens and Immigration and of the Minister for Relations with the Citizens and Immigration:

THAT the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the signing of certain acts, documents or writings by members of the personnel of the Conseil du trésor assigned to government services, attached to this Order in Council, be made.

# Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the signing of certain acts, documents or writings by members of the personnel of the Conseil du trésor assigned to government services

An Act respecting government services to departments and public bodies (R.S.Q., c. S-6.1, ss. 8 and 28)

**1.** The Regulation respecting the signing of certain acts, documents or writings by members of the personnel of the Conseil du trésor assigned to government services, made by Order in Council 1433-94 dated 7 September 1994 and amended by Orders in Council 1637-94 dated 24 November 1994 and 599-95 dated 3 May 1995, is further amended by substituting the following for the Title:

"Regulation respecting the signing of certain acts, documents or writings by the personnel assigned to government services".

- **2.** Section 1 is amended by deleting the words "of the Conseil du trésor".
- **3.** The following is inserted after section 2:
- **"2.1** An associate deputy minister and an assistant deputy minister are authorized to sign all contracts.".
- **4.** This Regulation comes into force on 1 October 1996.

#### Order No 96-04 of the Minister of Health and Social Services dated September 5, 1996

An Act respecting health services and social services (R.S.Q., c. S-4.2)

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting building construction by establishments, regional councils and the Corporation d'hébergement du Québec

WHEREAS under section 485 of the Act respecting health services and social services (R.S.Q., c. S-4.2), the Minister of Health and Social Services may, with the approval of the Conseil du trésor, make regulations applicable to institutions and regional boards, and to the Corporation d'hébergement du Québec respecting the standards, conditions and procedure to be observed for procurement of goods and services, joint purchases and mandates given for that purpose, franchising of services, construction of immovables, alienation of property, leasing of immovables and contracts related to such matters;

WHEREAS the Regulation respecting building construction by establishments, regional councils and the Corporation d'hébergement du Québec, approved by the Conseil du trésor by decision T.B. 148183 dated 10 January 1984 and amended by the Regulation made by Minister's Order 94-01 dated 28 April 1994, prescribes in section 11 that tenders for professional services shall be invited by public call for tenders where the estimated cost of the work is greater than \$10 000 000 in which case the call for tenders shall be addressed exclusively to teams, and by invitation to tender in all other cases;

WHEREAS under the same section, the owner may choose to make a public call for tenders where the estimated cost of the work is greater than \$5 000 000;

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the Regulation so that public calls for tenders be opened to any firm in the specialization determined by the owner and that such soliciting procedure be used where the estimated cost of the work is equal to or greater than \$5 000 000;

WHEREAS under section 12 of the Regulations Act (R.S.Q., c. R-18.1), a proposed regulation may be made without having been published as prescribed in section 8 of that Act if the authority making it is of the opinion that the urgency of the situation requires it;

WHEREAS under section 18 of that Act, a regulation may come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* where the authority that has made it is of the opinion that the urgency of the situation requires it;

WHEREAS under sections 13 and 18 of that Act, the reason justifying the absence of prior publication and such coming into force shall be published with the Regulation:

WHEREAS in the opinion of the Minister of Health and Social Services, the urgency to make changes to the procedure for awarding contracts for services under the Regulation justifies the absence of prior publication and such coming into force:

- team-based selection does not confer any significant advantage since nothing guarantees that the firm with the best expertise in a specialization will be selected on a team:
- the imminence of several large-scale construction projects in the health and social services network;
- the health and social services network remains the only network of public or parapublic bodies to reserve a category of projects to teams;
- those amendments are in keeping with the will of the Government to harmonize its present regulations;

WHEREAS by T.B. decision C.T. 189191 dated August 14, 1996, the Conseil du trésor has given its approval for the making of the Regulation, attached hereto, by the Minister;

THEREFORE, the Minister of Health and Social Services makes the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting building construction by establishments, regional councils and the Corporation d'hébergement du Québec, the text of which is attached to this Order.

#### Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting building construction by establishments, regional councils and the Corporation d'hébergement du Québec

An Act respecting health services and social services (R.S.Q., c. S-4.2, s. 485)

- **1.** The Regulation respecting building construction by establishments, regional councils and the Corporation d'hébergement du Québec, approved by the Conseil du trésor by T.B. decision 148183 dated 10 January 1984 and amended by the Regulation made by Minister's Order 94-01 dated 28 April 1994, is further amended in section 2
- (1) by striking out the words "forming one of the members of a team" in paragraph 7;
  - (2) by deleting paragraph 8;
  - (3) by substituting the following for paragraph 9:
- "(9) "central register" means the central register of suppliers of goods and services to the Government referred to in the Regulation respecting services contracts of government departments and public bodies, made by Order in Council 1169-93 dated 18 August 1993:":
- (4) by substituting the words "of firms that have offered their professional services for construction-related work and that are entered in the central register" for the words "drawn up under Directive 3-78 of the Conseil du trésor" in paragraph 11.
- **2.** The following is substituted for section 11:
- **"11. Call for tenders:** Tenders for services shall be called:
- (1) by invitation to tender using the central register, where the estimated cost of the work is equal to or greater than \$100 000 but less than \$5 000 000; or
- (2) by public call for tenders, where the estimated cost of the work is equal to or greater than \$5 000 000.".
- **3.** Section 13 is amended
  - (1) by substituting the following for paragraph 2:
- "(2) the profession and specializations of the members of the firms invited to tender for services;";
  - (2) by substituting the following for paragraph 6:

- "(6) in the case of a public call for tenders, a statement that tenders will be considered only from firms that have their principal place of business in Québec;"; and
  - (3) by striking out the words "or team" in paragraph 7.
- **4.** The words "for firms and 4 weeks for teams" are struck out in section 14.
- **5.** The words "or to teams" are struck out in section 15.
- **6.** The words "or a team" are struck out in section 17.
- **7.** Section 20 is amended
- (1) by striking out the words "or of all the members of the firm" in subparagraph *b* of paragraph 1; and
  - (2) by substituting the following for paragraph 2:
- "(2) to analyze the tenders and assess them according to the assessment criteria set out in the documents given to the firms that have offered their services, each member being required to make his own assessment and to send the results to the secretary for compilation by him; and".
- **8.** The words "or the team" and "or team" are struck out in section 22.
- **9.** Section 28 is amended
- (1) by substituting the words "central register" for the words "Central Index of Government of Québec Suppliers under Directive 1-79 of the Conseil du trésor" in the second paragraph; and
- (2) by substituting the words "central register" for the words "Central Index of Government of Québec Suppliers" in the third paragraph.
- **10.** The second sentence in section 42 is deleted.
- **11.** The words "central register" are substituted for the words "Central Index of Government of Québec Suppliers" in subparagraph 1 of the first paragraph of section 44.
- **12.** This Regulation comes into force on the day of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.

### Order of the Minister of the Environment and Wildlife dated August 29, 1996

An Act to amend the Act to preserve agricultural land and other legislative provisions in order to promote the preservation of agricultural activities (1996, c. 26)

RESPECTING the Guidelines concerning the Prevention of Air Pollution in Livestock Operations

WHEREAS the Act to amend the Act to preserve agricultural land and other legislative provisions in order to promote the preservation of agricultural activities (1996, c. 26) was assented to on June 20, 1996;

WHEREAS section 79.17 of the Act to preserve agricultural land, enacted by section 47 of the amending Act, provides for immunity from prosecution with regard to odours resulting from agricultural activities in an agricultural zone, insofar as such activities are exercised in accordance with the municipal regulatory standards adopted under the third paragraph of section 113 of the Act respecting land use planning and development;

WHEREAS under section 87 of the amending Act, until the coming into force of a regulation respecting odours and passed by a municipality, immunity from prosecution also applies with regard to odours caused by agricultural activities exercised in an agricultural zone in the territory of that municipality, if such activities are exercised in accordance with the standards provided by the Guidelines concerning the prevention of air pollution in livestock operations, drafted by the Minister of the Environment and Wildlife and published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*;

WHEREAS it is in the public's interest that those persons concerned by such immunity may take note of these Guidelines as soon as possible, prior to the coming into force of the Act to amend the Act to preserve agricultural land and other legislative provisions in order to promote the preservation of agricultural activities:

THEREFORE, the Minister of the Environment and Wildlife hereby issues and publishes the Guidelines concerning the prevention of air pollution in livestock operations, whose text appears below.

DAVID CLICHE, Minister of the Environment and Wildlife GUIDELINES OF THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT AND WILDLIFE CONCERNING THE PREVENTION OF AIR POLLUTION IN LIVESTOCK OPERATIONS May 14, 1996

#### **General Objective**

The objective of these guidelines is to prevent and reduce air contamination, especially odours, so as to provide citizens residing in the vicinity of a livestock operation with an air quality comparable to that which existed when they first resided there.

#### **Presentation of the Guidelines**

Currently, the best-known and most frequently-used technology for eliminating or reducing odours from live-stock operations is based on the dilution of the odours in a large air mass to render them imperceptible. This means that dwellings must be distanced from odour-producing operations.

Before June 10, 1981, the standards used for the granting of certificates of conformity by the Ministère de l'Environnement were those published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* on August 30, 1978, as part of the advance publication of the "Draft Regulation respecting livestock operations". In addition to standards designed to prevent contamination of water and underground water tables, the draft regulation also proposed certain standards to prevent air contamination by odours.

On June 10, 1981, the "Regulation respecting the prevention of water pollution in livestock operations" came into force. These guidelines are intended to complement the current regulation by introducing standards for protection against air pollution. Clearly, these standards do not have the same regulatory status as the provisions of the Regulation itself, but they nevertheless constitute the basic criteria used by the Ministère de l'Environnement when examining projects and processing the cases that may be brought to its attention. In some specific cases, additional requirements may be imposed. Similarly, derogations from the standards may be permitted where the Department considers that the quality of the environment can still be protected.

#### Use of the Guidelines

The standards and definitions set out below are in addition to the provisions of the "Regulation respecting the prevention of water pollution in livestock operations" as published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* on June 10, 1981. The standards and definitions apply in particular to all applications for certificates of authori-

zation under the Regulation. Naturally, the definitions contained in the Regulation apply, adapted as required, to these guidelines.

#### INTERPRETATION

#### **Definitions:**

- (a) "Population centre":
- i. a group of at least five dwellings
- 1. none of which is inhabited by a farm producer;
- 2. which are situated within a diameter of 150 metres; and
- 3. which are located anywhere in Québec, other than in an agricultural zone designated under sections 47 to 53 of the Act to preserve agricultural land (R.S.Q., c. P-41.1); or
  - ii. a group of at least three dwellings
  - 1. none of which is inhabited by a farm producer;
  - 2. which are situated within a diameter of 300 metres;
- 3. which are situated outside an agricultural zone designated under sections 47 to 53 of the Act to preserve agricultural land (R.S.Q., c. P-41.1);
- 4. which are all situated within the territorial boundaries of a village, town or city municipality; and
- 5. at least one of which is located less than 300 metres from another dwelling that is not itself inhabited by a farm producer but that is also situated within the territorial boundaries of a village, town or city municipality;
- (b) "public highway": a roadway designed for automobile traffic, maintained by a municipality or by the Ministère des Transports;
- (c) "exposed": located within the area formed by two imaginary straight parallel lines beginning 100 metres from the ends of a livestock operation and extending into infinity, in the direction of a prevailing summer wind:
- (d) "dwelling": a permanent construction intended to accommodate human beings and equipped with underground water supply and wastewater disposal facilities;
- (e) "owner's dwelling": a dwelling that belongs to the owner of a livestock operation to which a standard stipulated in Schedules A to L is applied;
- (f) "neighbouring dwelling": a dwelling other than the owner's dwelling;

- (g) "protected immovable": a municipal park, campground, a restaurant with at least 20 seats or a hotel with a permit issued under the Hotels Act (R.S.Q., c. H-3), an outdoor recreational area, a vacation village, a public beach, an educational institution, a religious temple, an establishment to which the Act respecting health services and social services (R.S.Q., c. S-5) applies, or an apartment building of five dwellings or more;
- (h) "total number": the number of animals contained in all the buildings or yards of a livestock operation located less than 150 metres from one another and belonging directly or indirectly to the same owner, or using a common manure management system, including the animals that will be added in accordance with an application for a certificate of authorization;
- (i) "prevailing summer wind": a wind blowing more than 25 % of the time in one direction during the months of June, July and August combined, as assessed by the meteorological station most representative of the site of the livestock operation.

#### SITING STANDARDS

**Location**: It is prohibited to establish a new livestock operation, to enlarge an existing livestock operation, to change a type of livestock operation, to increase the number of animal units or to construct or modify a manure storage site in the following locations:

- (a) within the limits of a town, city or village municipality, except where the livestock operation or manure storage site is located in an agricultural zone designated under sections 47 to 53 of the Act to preserve agricultural land (R.S.O., c. P-41.1);
- (b) within a territory zoned for residential, commercial or mixed (residential and commercial) purposes by a parish, township or united township municipality or by an undesignated municipality, except where the livestock operation or manure storage site is located in an agricultural zone designated under sections 47 to 53 of the Act to preserve agricultural land (R.S.Q., c. P-41.1);
- (c) at a distance of less than that stipulated in Schedules A to L between the livestock operation or manure storage site and a population centre, protected immovable, neighbouring dwelling, owner's dwelling, public highway or lot line, according to the type of livestock concerned.

**Exceptions**: The provisions of paragraph *a* do not apply to a type of livestock described in Schedule C or D, located within the boundaries of a village municipality. However, the siting standards referred to in para-

graph b apply, adapted as required, in respect of all such types of livestock located within the boundaries of such a municipality.

It is nevertheless permitted to carry out a project referred to in paragraph *a* in a town, city or village municipality if expressly permitted by a municipal by-law.

A manure storage site may also be built or modified in the locations referred to in paragraphs a, b and c if the said storage site is intended to receive manure produced by a livestock operation established before the Regulation respecting the prevention of water pollution in livestock operations came into force, and if it complies with the specific distance standards stipulated in the "Manure Storage" Division, "Special Cases" section.

**Distances from municipal zones**: The distance standards stipulated in Schedules A to L between a livestock operation or manure storage site and a population centre apply, adapted as required, between such a livestock operation or manure storage site and the boundaries of any town, city or village municipality or of any territory zoned for residential, commercial or mixed (residential and commercial) purposes by a parish, township or united township municipality or by an undesignated municipality.

The said standards do not apply, however, if the land located at the boundaries of the said town, city or village municipalities and the land zoned for residential, commercial or mixed (residential and commercial) purposes by a parish, township or united township municipality or by an undesignated municipality has been designated as an agricultural zone under the Act to preserve agricultural land.

Maximum number of animal units: In applying the siting standards stipulated in Schedules A to J, an enlargement or increase in the number of animal units that exceeds the maximum number of animal units listed in Schedules A to J shall be considered to be a new livestock operation.

Where a change in the type of livestock exceeds the maximum number of animal units permitted, the highest siting standards applicable to an enlargement apply between the building or yard and the owner's dwelling, the lot line and the centre of the public highway.

**Specific change in the type of livestock**: The siting standards stipulated for a building and yard do not apply to a change in the type of livestock covered by Schedule M.

Mixed livestock: Where two or more types of livestock are raised or to be raised in the same livestock operation, the siting standards governing the type of livestock with the highest number of animal units shall apply. However, such standards cannot be lower than those that would apply if the number of animal units for each species were to be counted separately.

To establish which siting standards apply, the total number of animal units in the livestock operation is established, and such total is then applied to the type of livestock having the most animal units.

#### MANURE STORAGE

**Required distances**: Every manure storage site intended to serve a new livestock operation, an enlargement a change in the type of livestock or an increase in the number of animal units shall be located in accordance with the siting standards stipulated in Schedules A to J, by anticipated type of livestock, unless the manure is spread directly on the ground after each livestock period.

Where a manure storage site would be located more than 100 metres from the livestock operation, it must comply with the siting standards stipulated in Schedules K and L.

**Special cases**: The construction or modification of a manure storage site that does not comply with the general siting standards described in the "Location" section, and that is intended to serve an existing livestock operation that has not been modified since the Regulation came into force, shall be located at least 75 metres from any neighbouring dwelling, except where it is a closed storage site.

For all points of reference mentioned in Schedules A to L, the storage site shall be located at distances equal or superior to those already existing, except where the building or yard is itself located beyond the siting standards stipulated in the said Schedules.

#### ELIMINATION OF MANURE

**Proximity of neighbouring dwellings**: Except in the case of manure buried in the ground during spreading and odourless oxygenized manure, liquid manure shall be spread at least 300 metres from any neighbouring dwellings. In the case of solid manure, the applicable minimum distance from a neighbouring dwelling is 75 metres.

Order of the Minister responsible for the Act respecting immigration to Québec dated 9 September 1996

An Act respecting immigration to Québec (R.S.Q., c. I-0.2; 1993, c. 70)

Regulation respecting the weighting applicable to the selection of foreign nationals

CONSIDERING that, under section 3.4 of the Act respecting immigration to Québec (R.S.Q., c. I-0.2), introduced by section 12 of the Act to amend the Act respecting the Ministère des Communautés culturelles et de l'Immigration (1993, c. 70), the Minister may, by regulation, establish the weighting of selection criteria for foreign nationals and the passing score and, where expedient, the cutoff score determined in relation to a selection criterion, applicable to the preliminary stage of selection and to the selection, which weighting and scores may vary according to the family situation of the foreign national, according to the classes of foreign nationals and within the same class of foreign nationals;

The Minister responsible for the Act respecting immigration to Québec makes the Regulation respecting the weighting applicable to the selection of foreign nationals, attached to this Minister's Order.
