Bras-Coupé-Désert, Capitachouane and Kipawa Controlled Zones

WHEREAS under section 104 of the Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (R.S.Q., c. C-61.1), the Government may, by order, establish controlled zones on land in the public domain for the development, harvesting and conservation of wildlife or a species of wildlife;

WHEREAS in accordance with section 104 of the Act, the Bras-Coupé-Désert Controlled Zone was established for the development, harvesting and conservation of wildlife or a species of wildlife by Décret 568-87 dated 8 April 1987 amended by Décrets 849-91 dated 19 June 1991 and 22-96 dated 10 January 1996;

WHEREAS in accordance with section 104 of the Act, the Capitachouane Controlled Zone was established for the development, harvesting and conservation of wildlife or a species of wildlife by Décret 568-87 dated 8 April 1987;

WHEREAS in accordance with section 104 of the Act, the Kipawa Controlled Zone was established for the development, harvesting and conservation of wildlife or a species of wildlife by Décret 510-89 dated 5 April 1989 and amended by Décret 1715-91 dated 11 December 1991:

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the territory of the Bras-Coupé-Désert, Capitachouane and Kipawa Controlled Zones:

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, upon the recommendation of the Minister of the Environment and Wildlife:

THAT Décret 568-87 dated 8 April 1987 establishing the Bras-Coupé-Désert Controlled Zone be amended by substituting Schedule 3 respecting the Bras-Coupé-Désert Controlled Zone, attached to this Order in Council, for Schedule 3;

THAT Décret 568-87 dated 8 April 1987 establishing the Capitachouane Controlled Zone be amended, in its French text, by substituting Schedule 4 of the Capitachouane Controlled Zone, attached hereto, for Schedule 4 and by adding the English text of the Schedule attached to this Order in Council;

THAT Décret 510-89 establishing the Kipawa Controlled Zone be amended, in its French text, by substituting Schedule II respecting the Kipawa Controlled Zone, attached hereto, for Schedule II and by adding the English text of the Schedule attached to this Order in Council:

THAT this Order in Council come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.

SCHEDULE 3

Thence, northwesterly, a straight line to its meeting point with the northwest corner of the Canton de Béliveau; Thence, westerly, the southern limit of the Canton d'Angoumois to point 2 located on the left bank of the tributary of Lac Inman, point whose coordinates are:

5 141 500 mN and 395 200 mE;

Segment 2-3

From point 2, northwesterly then northeasterly, the left bank of the tributary of Lac Inman, so as to include it; the shore of Lac Inman, so as to exclude it; the left bank of the effluent of Lac Inman, so as to include it, to its meeting point with the northeastern limit of the road leading to Lac David, point whose coordinates are:

5 144 800 mN and 392 550 mE;

Thence, northwesterly, that right-of-way limit (12 m) and its extension to its meeting point with the east shore of Lac David;

Thence, northeasterly then northwesterly, the shore of that lake, so as to exclude it, to its meeting point with the left bank of a tributary located at the north end of Lac David;

Thence, northeasterly, the bank of that tributary to its meeting point with the southwestern limit of the right-of-way (12 m) of route 12, point whose coordinates are: 5 150 500 mN and 390 175 mE;

Thence, northwesterly then northeasterly, that right-of-way limit and the right-of-way (12 m) of route 13 A to point 3 located on the southern limit of the right-of-way of route 13, point whose coordinates are:

5 166 800 mN and 383 550 mE;

Segment 3-4

From point 3, northwesterly, that right-of-way limit to a point whose coordinates are:

5 173 450 mN and 370 400 mE;

Thence, northeasterly, a straight line to a point located 60 m from the left bank of the tributary of Lac Pelletier, point whose coordinates are:

5 173 525 mN and 370 450 mE;

Thence, northwesterly then northeasterly, a line parallel to and 60 m from a string of brooks and lakes to a point whose coordinates are:

5 175 350 mN and 369 800 mE

Thence, northeasterly, a broken line passing by the following points:

- 5 175 650 mN and 370 000 mE;
- 5 178 550 mN and 370 000 mE;
- 5 178 450 mN and 376 500 mE;
- 5 179 150 mN and 377 000 mE;
- 5 182 150 mN and 378 700 mE;

the latter point being located on the northern limit of the right-of-way (12 m) of a forest road passing north of Lac Altud;

Thence, northwesterly then northeasterly, that right-of-way limit to the southern limit of the right-of-way (12 m) of a forest road passing south of Lac Gill;

Thence, southwesterly then northwesterly, that rightof-way limit to a point located 60 m from the left bank of a tributary of that lake, point whose coordinates are:

5 183 350 mN and 376 950 mE;

Thence, northeasterly, a line parallel to and 60 m from the banks and shores of a string of brooks and lakes, including Lac Gill, so as to include them, to a point whose coordinates are:

5 184 600 mN and 379 400 mE;

Thence, northeasterly, a straight line to its meeting point with the western limit of the right-of-way (12 m) of a secondary road leading to Lac Putnam, point whose coordinates are:

5 184 750 mN and 380 360 mE;

Thence, southeasterly, that right-of-way limit and the southwestern limit of the right-of-way (12 m) of secondary road No. 14, to its meeting point with the right bank of Ruisseau Fraser, point whose coordinates are:

5 182 425 mN and 384 075 mE;

Thence, southeasterly, successively following, so as to exclude them, the right bank of that brook, the shore of Lac Savary and Petit Lac Savary, the bank of the effluent of Lac Savary, the shore of Lac Tomasine, Rivière Tomasine, du Pont lakes, to point 4 located on the northern limit of the right-of-way (15 m) of road No. 10, point whose coordinates are:

5 169 450 mN and 402 400 mE;

Segment 4-5

From point 4, northeasterly, that right-of-way limit, so as to include it and the northern limit of the right-of-way (12 m) of the forest road alongside the northern limit of the Canton de Lytton to the western limit of the right-of-way (30 m) of route 117; southeasterly, the western limit of that right-of-way to the southern limit of the right-of-way (12 m) of the latter forest road; westerly, the southern limit of the right-of-way of that road to its meeting point with the right bank of Ruisseau Quinn;

Thence, southwesterly, the bank of that brook and the bank of Rivière Désert, so as to exclude them, to a point located on the extension of an effluent, point whose coordinates are:

5 170 800 mN and 416 050 mE;

Thence, southwesterly, that extension and the bank of that effluent, so as to include it, to a point whose coordinates are:

5 169 950 mN and 415 550 mE;

Thence, northwesterly then southerly, a broken line passing by the following points:

5 170 475 mN and 414 500 mE;

5 167 700 mN and 414 500 mE;

the latter point being located on the north shore of Lac Lytton;

Thence, southeasterly, the shore of Lac Lytton, so as to include it, to point 5 located on the western limit of Rang VIII of Canton de Lytton, point whose coordinates are:

5 164 650 mN and 415 350 mE;

Segment 5-1

From point 5, southerly, the western limit of the said Rang VIII, skirting the lakes met there, so as to include them, to its meeting point with the southern limit of the Canton de Lytton;

Thence, westerly, the southern limit of the Canton de Lytton, the shore of Lac Étroit, so as to include it, to its meeting point with the eastern limit of Rang VIII of the Canton d'Égan;

Thence, southerly, the eastern limit of that range to the dividing line between lots 72 and 73 of Rang VIII of that township;

Thence, southwesterly, a straight line to a point located on the southeast shore of Lac Bon à Rien and on the eastern limit of the Canton d'Angoumois; southerly, the eastern limit of that township to its meeting point with the left bank of the effluent of Lac Harding, skirting the shore of that lake, so as to include it;

Thence, southeasterly, the bank of the effluent of Lac Harding, so as to include it, to the starting point.

To be included in that territory, in the Canton de Mitchell, the portion of the right-of-way (15 m) of road No. 10 located between route 117 and its meeting point with the old access road to Réserve Faunique de La Vérendrye.

The U.T.M. coordinates mentioned above were graphically traced from maps to the scale of 1:50 000 published by the Department of Energy, Mines and Resources of Canada. (N.A.D. 1927, Zone 18).



Segment 4-5

From point 4, a straight line to the south end of Lac Ploegsteert, point whose coordinates are:

From point 6, northeasterly, a broken line whose apexes are identified by the following coordinates:

that point being located on the west shore of Lac Masnières; easterly, the shore of that lake, so as to include it, to its eastern end, point whose coordinates are:

Thence, easterly, southerly then easterly, a broken line passing by the following points:

5 300 525 mN and 387 800 mE;

being point 7 located at the meeting point with the right bank of the effluent of Lac Kylie;

Segment 7-8

From point 7, southeasterly, following, so as to exclude them, the bank of the effluent of Lac Kylie, the shore of an unnamed lake, the bank of the tributary of Lac Akos, the shore of Lac Akos, the bank of Rivière Camachigama to point 8, point whose coordinates are:

5 291 300 mN and 393 100 mE;

Segment 8-9

From point 8, easterly, a straight line to its meeting point with the left bank of the effluent of Lac Bricault; southeasterly, following successively, so as to exclude them, the bank of the effluent of Lac Bricault, the shore of Lac Bricault, the bank of the effluent of Lac Carr, the shore of Lac Carr, the bank of the tributary of Lac Carr, the shore of Lac Chinon, the bank of the effluent of Lac Chinon, the shore of an unnamed lake and the bank of Rivière des Outaouais (main channel) to point 9 whose coordinates are:

5 281 950 mN and 395 900 mE;

Segment 9-10

From point 9, southerly, a straight line to the left bank of Rivière des Outaouais (south channel);

Thence, southerly, that bank to its meeting point with the southern limit of the bridge crossing the river, point whose coordinates are:

Thence, easterly, the southern limit of that bridge; southerly, the limit of the right-of-way (10 m) of the road, so as to exclude it, to its meeting point with the southern limit of the right-of-way (10 m) of the road passing south of Lac Somers, point whose coordinates are:

Thence, southwesterly, that right-of-way limit, so as to include it, to point 10 located at the meeting point with the right bank of the effluent of Lac Clytte, point whose coordinates are:

Segment 10-11

From point 10, southerly, following, so as to include them, the bank of the effluent of Lac Clytte, the shore of Lac Clytte, the bank of Ruisseau Spruce to its meeting point with the shore of Lac de l'Enfer, point whose coordinates are:

5 265 900 mN and 395 200 mE;

Thence, southerly, a straight line to a point located on the southeastern limit of the right-of-way (10 m) of a road leading to Lac Rock, point whose coordinates are:

5 265 400 mN and 395 350 mE;

Thence, southwesterly, that right-of-way limit to point 11 located at the meeting point with the left bank of the effluent of Lac Rock, point whose coordinates are:

5 262 800 mN and 392 500 mE;

Segment 11-1

From that point, westerly then northwesterly, the left bank of the effluent of Lac Rock, the west shore and the right bank of a string of lakes and brooks and the west shore of Lac Lindsay including the site of a cottage located on the shore of that lake (file MRN 120216) to the starting point.

Area: 848.3 km²

Territory B

Starting from the meeting point of the parallel of latitude 47° 51' north and of the meridian of longitude 76° 30' west:

Thence, easterly, the said parallel of latitude to its meeting point with the eastern limit of the Canton de Cambrai:

Thence, westerly, a straight line to a point whose coordinates are:

Thence, southerly, a straight line to the starting point.



Thence, southeasterly, that right-of-way limit, so as to include it, to a point located on the northern limit of the right-of-way (10 m) of a road passing north of Lac Chenon, point whose coordinates are:

5 245 625 mN and 684 700 mE;

Thence, northeasterly then southeasterly, that right-of-way limit (10 m), so as to include it, to point 8, point whose coordinates are:

5 204 475 mN and 703 150 mE;

Segment 8-9

Thence, westerly, the limit of that township to a point located 60 m from an unnamed lake, point whose coordinates are:

Thence, northeasterly then southwesterly, a line parallel to and 60 m from the shores and banks of a string of lakes and brooks, so as to exclude them, to a point whose coordinates are:

- 5 237 250 mN and 699 325 mE:

the latter point being located on the northern limit of a road leading to Belleterre;

Thence, northwesterly, that right-of-way limit (10 m) to point 9 located 60 m from a tributary of Lac à la Truite, point whose coordinates are:

From point 9, northwesterly, southeasterly then southwesterly, a line parallel to and 60 m from the banks and shores of a string of brooks and lakes, so as to exclude them, to a point whose coordinates are:

Thence, southwesterly, easterly then northeasterly, a broken line whose apex coordinates are:

- 5 233 000 mN and 696 875 mE:

that point is located 60 m from the left bank of a tributary of Lac à la Truite;

Thence, northeasterly, a line parallel to and 60 m from the banks and shores of a string of brooks and lakes, so as to exclude them, to a point whose coordinates are:

5 242 775 mN and 713 650 mE;

Thence, southeasterly, a straight line to a point located 60 m from the bank of a brook, point whose coordinates are:

5 242 725 mN and 714 300 mE;

Thence, southeasterly, a line parallel to and 60 m from the banks and shores of a string of brooks and lakes, so as to exclude them, to a point whose coordinates are:

5 241 975 mN and 714 550 mE;

Thence, southeasterly, a straight line to a point located 60 m from the shore of an unnamed lake, point whose coordinates are:

5 241 000 mN and 715 225 mE;

Thence, northeasterly, southeasterly then northeasterly, a line parallel to and 60 m from a string of lakes and brooks, so as to include them, to a point located north of Lac Clover, point whose coordinates are:

5 241 975 mN and 718 350 mE;

Thence, northeasterly, a straight line to point 11 located 60 m from the southeast shore of an unnamed lake, point whose coordinates are:

5 243 550 mN and 719 200 mE;

Segment 11-12

From point 11, northeasterly then southeasterly, a line parallel to and 60 m from the shore of the latter lake and of Lac Hoff, so as to exclude them, to a point whose coordinates are:

5 244 300 mN and 720 850 mE;

Thence, northeasterly, a straight line to a point located on the left bank of the effluent of Lac des Quatre Milles, point whose coordinates are:

5 244 650 mN and 721 625 mE;

Thence, southwesterly then southeasterly, the bank of that effluent, the shore of Lac des Quatre Milles, the bank of its tributary, so as to exclude them and the north shore of an unnamed lake, so as to include it, to a point located on the northern limit of the Canton de Maupassant, point whose coordinates are:

5 239 175 mN and 623 600 mE;

Thence, easterly, the limit of that township to point 12 located on the left bank of the tributary of Lac Padoue, skirting to the north the unnamed lakes met there and lakes Legros and Néré, so as to include them, point whose coordinates are:

5 239 050 mN and 278 200 mE;

Segment 12-1

From point 12, southeasterly, the bank of that tributary, the shore of Lac Litvine, the bank of the effluent of Lac Roger, the bank of the effluent of Lac Grailly and the shore of Lac Grailly, so as to exclude them, to a point whose coordinates are:

5 235 350 mN and 279 400 mE;

Thence, southwesterly, a straight line to a point located on the north shore of an unnamed lake, point whose coordinates are:

5 235 150 mN and 279 150 mE;

Thence, southwesterly then southeasterly, the shores and banks of a string of lakes and brooks, so as to exclude them, including lakes Pickerel and Crutch, Ruisseau Crutch, Lac aux Écorces and Baie aux Chicots of Lac Dumoine, to the starting point.

Note: When the shore of a body of water or the bank of a watercourse is mentioned, reference is always made to the outside limit of the shore or bank, that is the normal high water mark.

The U.T.M. coordinates mentioned above were graphically traced from maps to the scale of 1:50 000 published by the Department of Energy, Mines and Resources of Canada. (N.A.D. 1927, Zone 18).
