EXPLANATORY NOTE

The object of this bill is to authorize the Government to pay out of the consolidated revenue fund the sum of \$416,100,000.00 being the appropriations to be voted for each of the programs of the portfolios listed in the Schedule and representing the 1997-98 Supplementary Estimates No. 2.

APPROPRIATION ACT NO. 5, 1997-98

THE PARLIAMENT OF QUÉBEC ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Government may draw out of the consolidated revenue fund a sum not exceeding \$416,100,000.00 to defray a part of the Expenditure Budget of Québec proposed in the Supplementary Estimates for the fiscal year 1997-98 as laid before the National Assembly, not otherwise provided for, being the amount of each of the estimates to be voted for various programs set forth in the Schedule to this Act.
- **2.** This Act comes into force on 11 November 1997.
