An Act to establish a fund to combat poverty through reintegration into the labour market (1997, c. 28)

Date on which the Act ceases to have effect

Date on which the Act to establish a fund to combat poverty through reintegration into the labour market ceases to have effect

WHEREAS the Act to establish a fund to combat poverty through reintegration into the labour market (1997, c. 28) was assented to on 12 June 1997;

WHEREAS under section 15 of the Act, it has effect from 26 November 1996 and will cease to have effect on 1 April 2000 or on any later date determined by the Government;

WHEREAS the Fund to combat poverty through reintegration into the labour market is designed to finance projects accepted prior to 1 April 2000 but, because of the time needed for their carrying out, some commitments and payments must be made in connection with them after 31 March 2000;

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Fund cease to have effect on 1 April 2001, so that the projects may be carried out;

WHEREAS under Order in Council 1509-98 dated 15 December 1998, the Minister of Social Solidarity was designated by the Government Minister responsible for the administration of the Act to establish a fund to combat poverty through reintegration into the labour market;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Social Solidarity:

THAT the Act to establish a fund to combat poverty through reintegration into the labour market (1997, c. 28) cease to have effect on 1 April 2001.
