Order of the Minister of Transport dated 31 March 1999 concerning exemptions from stopping before crossing certain level crossings

Highway Safety Code
(R.S.Q., c. C-24.2)

THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT,

CONSIDERING section 414 of the Highway Safety Code (R.S.Q., c. C-24.2), which allows him to designate, by an order published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*, certain level crossings where the driver of a road vehicle referred to in section 413 is exempt from the obligations under the said section;

CONSIDERING the designation, by a Minister's Order dated 13 December 1993, of certain level crossings where the danger of accidents was considerably reduced due to the presence of safety devices and the infrequency of rail traffic or a crossing procedure requiring that trains be stopped systematically;

CONSIDERING that it is expedient to update those exemptions since one of those crossings has been abandoned and another one has seen an increase in rail traffic which increases the risk of accident;

Designates, therefore, the following level crossings where the driver of a road vehicle referred to in section 413 of the Highway Safety Code is exempt from the obligations under the said section:

- (1) the level crossing on Autoroute 20, on the territory of the Municipalité de Saint-Hyacinthe (54045);
- (2) the level crossing located on Route 170, on the territory of the Municipalité de La Baie (94040); and
- (3) the level crossing located on Route 132, on the territory of the Municipalité de Rimouski-Est (10040);

Substitutes this Order, from the date of its publication, for the Order dated 13 December 1993 concerning exemptions from stopping before crossing certain level crossings.
