An Act respecting the legal publicity of sole proprietorships, partnerships and legal persons (R.S.Q., c. P-45)

Fees for the provision of compilations of information

Regulation respecting the fees for the provision of compilations of information

WHEREAS under section 77 of the Act respecting the legal publicity of sole proprietorships, partnerships and legal persons (R.S.Q., c. P-45), the Inspector General of Financial Institutions may determine the fees payable by any person requesting a compilation of the information contained in the statements of information;

WHEREAS the Regulation respecting the fees for the provision of compilations of information was approved by the Government by Order in Council 1453-98 dated 27 November 1998;

WHEREAS the Inspector General of Financial Institutions adopted a regulation replacing the Regulation respecting the fees for the provision of compilations of information in order to allow for the reduction of certain fees payable and to facilitate the application of the Regulation;

WHEREAS under section 77 of the Act respecting the legal publicity of sole proprietorships, partnerships and legal persons, such regulation is subject to Government approval;

WHEREAS under section 12 of the Regulations Act (R.S.Q., c. R-18.1), a proposed regulation may be made

without having been published in accordance with section 8 of that Act if the authority making it is of the opinion that the urgency of the situation requires it;

WHEREAS under section 18 of that Act, a regulation may come into force between the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* and the date applicable under section 17 of that Act where the authority that has made it is of the opinion that the urgency of the situation requires it;

WHEREAS under sections 13 and 18 of the Act, the reason justifying the absence of prior publication and such coming into force shall be published with the regulation;

WHEREAS the Government is of the opinion that the urgency due to the following circumstances justifies the absence of prior publication and such coming into force:

— those governed by the Regulation must be able to benefit as soon as possible from the reduction of certain fees which will, in particular, make the information contained in the register of sole proprietorships, partnerships and legal persons more accessible;

WHEREAS, it is expedient to approve the Regulation;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, upon the recommendation of the Minister of State for the Economy and Finance and Minister of Finance:

THAT the Regulation respecting the fees for the provision of compilations of information, attached to this Order in Council, be approved.

Regulation respecting the fees for the provision of compilations of information

An Act respecting the legal publicity of sole proprietorships, partnerships and legal persons (R.S.Q., c. P-45, s. 77)

1. The fees payable by any person requesting a compilation of the information contained in statements of information are \$100 per request.

Notwithstanding the first paragraph, where a request requires the processing of a number of registrant's records included in the statement of information that, calculated at \$0.20 per record, exceeds \$100, the fees payable shall be those resulting from the calculation.

2. In addition to the fees prescribed in section 1, the following fees are payable by any person requesting a compilation of information:

- (1) \$10, where the compilation is recorded on a disk;
- (2) \$10, where the compilation is provided by any means other than telematics;
- (3) \$0.05 for each sheet printed out, where the compilation is produced on paper.

3. This Regulation replaces the Regulation respecting the fees for the provision of compilations of information approved by Order in Council 1453-98 dated 27 November 1998.

4. This Regulation comes into force on 1 April 2000.

An Act respecting the Ministère de la Recherche, de la Science et de la Technologie (1999, c. 8)

Signing of certain deeds, documents or writings of the Ministère

Signing of certain deeds, documents or writings of the Ministère de la Recherche, de la Science et de la Technologie

WHEREAS the second paragraph of section 12 of the Act respecting the Ministère de la Recherche, de la Science et de la Technologie (1999, c. 8) provides that a deed, document or writing is binding on the Minister or may be attributed to him only if it is signed by the Minister, the Deputy Minister, a member of the personnel of the department or the holder of a position and, in the latter two cases, only so far as determined by the Government;

WHEREAS section 14 of that Act states that a document or copy of a document emanating from the department or forming part of its records, signed or certified true by a person referred to in the second paragraph of section 12 of the Act, is authentic;

WHEREAS it is expedient that the Government determine the deeds, documents or writings which, when signed by a member of the personnel of the department

or by the holder of a position, bind the Minister and may be attributed to him and it is expedient to authorize the persons referred to in the second paragraph of section 12 of the Act to certify as true a document or copy of a document emanating from the department or forming part of its records;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, upon the recommendation of the Minister of Research, Science and Technology:

THAT the Terms and conditions of the signing of certain deeds, documents or writings of the Ministère de la Recherche, de la Science et de la Technologie, attached to this Order in Council, be made.

THAT those terms and conditions come into force on the date of their publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.

SCHEDULE

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE SIGNING OF CERTAIN DEEDS, DOCUMENTS OR WRITINGS OF THE MINISTÈRE DE LA RECHERCHE, DE LA SCIENCE ET DE LA TECHNOLOGIE

1. The members of the personnel of the Ministère de la Recherche, de la Science et de la Technologie holding the positions referred to in this Schedule on a permanent or temporary basis are authorized to sign alone and with the same authority as the Minister of Research, Science and Technology the deeds, documents or writings listed after their respective positions under the conditions set forth in the Financial Administration Act (R.S.Q., c. A-6).

2. An assistant deputy minister is authorized to sign, for his sector of activity:

(1) calls for tenders and services contracts, except those related to information technologies;

(2) calls for tenders and supply contracts, except those related to information technologies;

(3) agreements on the granting of subsidies governed by standards approved by the Government or the Conseil du Trésor.

An assistant deputy minister is also authorized, for his sector of activity, to certify as true any document or copy of a document emanating from the department or forming part of its records.
