Order of the Minister responsible for Wildlife and Parks dated 4 May 2000

An Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (R.S.Q., c. C-61.1)

CONCERNING the establishment of the Deux-Montagnes Wildlife Sanctuary

THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR WILDLIFE AND PARKS

GIVEN that under section 122 of the Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (R.S.Q., c. C-61.1) amended by section 20 of Chapter 29 of the Acts of 1998 and by section 85 of Chapter 40 of the Acts of 1999, the Minister responsible for Wildlife and Parks may establish, after consultation with the Minister of Natural Resources, a wildlife sanctuary on lands in the domain of the State, private lands or both at once, the resources whereof may be used on conditions fixed in view of preserving the wildlife habitat or the habitat of a species of wildlife;

GIVEN that under paragraph 2 of section 122 of this Act, where the Minister wishes to include private land in a wildlife sanctuary, he shall first enter into an agreement to that effect with the owner;

CONSIDERING that the territory contemplated for the establishment of the Deux-Montagnes Wildlife Sanctuary is comprised of part of the Deux-Montagnes train station lot owned by the Agence métropolitaine de transport;

CONSIDERING that a memorandum of understanding between the Minister responsible for Wildlife and Parks and the Agence métropolitaine de transport for inclusion of this lot in the Deux-Montagnes Wildlife Sanctuary has been entered into;

CONSIDERING that it is expedient to establish the Deux-Montagnes Wildlife Sanctuary in order to conserve the habitat of the brown snake (*Storeria dekayi*)

ORDERS THAT:

The "Deux-Montagnes Wildlife Sanctuary", whose boundaries are delimited on the attached plan, be established:

This Order come into force on the day of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.
