automobile du Québec may issue one or more of the following documents: a registration certificate, registration plate, validation sticker, temporary registration certificate or detachable registration plate;

WHEREAS the Government made the Regulation respecting road vehicle registration by Order in Council 1420-91 dated 16 October 1991 and it is expedient to amend it to take into account the repeal of bulk trucking permits in the classification of registration plates;

WHEREAS in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (R.S.Q., c. R-18.1), the draft Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting road vehicle registration was published in Part 2 of the *Gazette officielle du Québec* of 23 December 1999, with a notice that it could be made by the Government upon the expiry of 45 days following that publication;

WHEREAS it is expedient to make the Regulation without amendment;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, upon the recommendation of the Minister of Transport:

THAT the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting road vehicle registration, attached to this Order in Council, be made.
