— Amendments

Regulation to amend the Plant Protection Regulation

WHEREAS under section 3 of the Plant Protection Act (R.S.Q., c. P-39.01), the Government shall make regulations determining the diseases and destructive insects against which plant protection measures may be taken;

WHEREAS the Plant Protection Regulation was made by Order in Council 1366-96 dated 6 November 1996;

WHEREAS in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (R.S.Q., c. R-18.1), a draft of the Regulation to amend the Plant Protection Regulation was published in Part 2 of the *Gazette officielle du Québec* of 15 August 2001 with a notice that it could be made by the Government upon the expiry of 45 days following this publication;

WHEREAS no comments were received following that publication;

WHEREAS it is expedient to make the Regulation with amendments:

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food:

THAT the Regulation to amend the Plant Protection Regulation, attached to this Order in Council, be made.

Regulation to amend the Plant Protection Regulation*

Plant Protection Act (R.S.Q., c. P-39.01, s. 3)

- 1. Section 1 of the Plant Protection Regulation is amended
 - (1) in the list of diseases
- (a) by substituting the following for the scientific name of the black knot:
 - "Apiosporina morbosa (Schwein.)";
- (b) by substituting the following for the scientific name of the crown gall:
 - "Agrobacterium tumefaciens (S. & T.)";
 - (2) in the list of destructive insects
- (a) by substituting the following for the scientific name of the plum curculio:
 - "Conotrachelus nenuphar (Hebst.)";
- (b) by substituting the following for the scientific name of the woolly apple aphid:
 - "Erisoma lanigerum (Hausm.)";
- (c) by substituting the following for the scientific name of the Fletcher scale:
 - "Parthenolecanium fletcheri (Ckll.)";
- (d) by substituting the following for the scientific name of the peach tree borer:
 - "Synanthedon exitiosa (Say)";
 - (e) by adding the following at the end:
 - "14. Blueberry maggot *Rhagoletis mendax* (Curran)".

- **2.** The French version of that section is amended
- (1) in the list of diseases, by substituting the words "Chancre européen" for the words "Chancre européen du pommier";
 - (2) in the list of destructive insects
- (a) by substituting the following for the scientific name of the *cochenille virgule du pommier*:

"Lepidosaphes ulmi (L.)";

(b) by substituting the following for the scientific name of the *mouche de la pomme*:

"Rhagoletis pomonella (Walsh)";

- (c) by substituting the words "Agrile du bouleau" for the words "Argile du bouleau".
- **3.** The French version of section 7 is amended by substituting the word "scellés" for the word "scellé".
- **4.** The French version of Schedule IV is amended by substituting the word "scellés" for the word "scellé" in Part C.
- **5.** This Regulation comes into force on the fifteenth day following the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.

Pits and quarries

— Amendment

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting pits and quarries

WHEREAS, under paragraph b of section 31 of the Environment Quality Act (R.S.Q., c. Q-2), the Government may make regulations to withdraw classes of contaminants or sources of contamination from the application of the Act or from any part of it;

WHEREAS, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (R.S.Q., c. R-18.1) and section 124 of the Environment Quality Act, a draft Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting pits and quarries was published in Part 2 of the *Gazette officielle du Québec* of 12 September 2001, with a notice that it could be made by the Government upon the expiry of 60 days following that publication;

WHEREAS it is expedient to make the Regulation with amendments, taking into account the comments received following the publication in the *Gazette officielle du Ouébec*;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, upon the recommendation of the Minister of State for Municipal Affairs and Greater Montréal, the Environment and Water and Minister of the Environment:

THAT the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting pits and quarries, attached to this Order in Council, be made.

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting pits and quarries*

Environment Quality Act (R.S.Q., c. Q-2, s. 31, par *b*)

- **1.** Section 1 of the Regulation respecting pits and quarries is amended by substituting, in paragraph f, the words ", apatite, barite, brucite, diamond, graphite, ilmenite, magnesite, phologopite, salt, silica, talc, wollastonite and metal mines, and except" for the words "and metal mines and".
- **2.** This Regulation comes into force on the fifteenth day following the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.
