Order of the Minister of State for Human Resources and Labour and Minister of Labour dated 27 March 2002

Building Act (R.S.Q., c. B-1.1)

> Delegation Agreement between the Régie du bâtiment du Québec and Ville de Montréal

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR HUMAN RESOURCES AND LABOUR AND MINISTER OF LABOUR,

CONSIDERING that the first paragraph of section 132 of the Building Act (R.S.Q., c. B-1.1), amended by section 37 of Chapter 46 of the Statutes of 1998, prescribes that the Régie du bâtiment du Québec may enter into a written agreement with a local municipality to delegate to it, within its territory and to the extent specified, its powers and duties pursuant to sections 14 to 19, 21, 22, 24 to 27, 32 to 37.2 and 37.4 to 39 of the Act with a view to ensuring the quality of construction work and public safety;

CONSIDERING that section 136 of the Act prescribes that the agreement requires approval by the Minister of State for Human Resources and Labour and Minister of Labour and comes into force on the tenth day following publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* of a notice to that effect or on any later date fixed therein;

CONSIDERING that the Delegation Agreement entered into on 17 May 2001 between the Régie du bâtiment du Québec and Ville de Montréal, approved by Minister's Order dated 18 May 2001, is in force until 31 March 2002;

CONSIDERING that the Delegation Agreement entered into on 26 March 2002 between the Régie du bâtiment du Québec and Ville de Montréal replaces the 17 May 2001 Agreement and that it will be in force until 30 June 2002;

CONSIDERING that it is expedient to approve the Agreement and to have it come into force ten days following publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* of this Minister's Order;

ORDERS

(1) THAT the Delegation Agreement entered into on 26 March 2002 between the Régie du bâtiment du Québec and Ville de Montréal be approved;

(2) THAT this Minister's Order be published in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*; and

(3) THAT the Agreement come into force on 7 April 2002.
