

M.O., 2002**Order of the Minister of Transport dated 29 November 2002**

Highway Safety Code
(R.S.Q., c. C-24.2)

Extension of the authorization to turn right on a red light

THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT,

CONSIDERING section 359.1 of the Highway Safety Code (R.S.Q., c. C-24.2);

CONSIDERING the Minister's Order dated 24 November 2000 (2002, *G.O.* 2, 5528) which authorizes right turns on a red light in certain municipalities designated therein until 15 January 2002;

CONSIDERING the Minister's Order dated 19 December 2001 (2001, *G.O.* 2, 6429) which extends that authorization until 15 January 2003;

CONSIDERING that it is expedient to extend that authorization until 12 April 2003;

ORDERS:

THAT the Minister's Order dated 24 November 2000, amended by the Minister's Order dated 19 December 2001, be further amended by substituting "12 April 2003" for "15 January 2003" in the operative part.

Table of income replacement indemnities for 2003

R-18.1) on page 3511 of the *Gazette officielle du Québec* of July 3, 2002 with a notice that, upon the expiry of 45 days following that publication, the Commission de la santé et de la sécurité du travail could adopt the final text.

Pursuant to section 63 of the Act respecting industrial accidents and occupational diseases, the “Regulation respecting the table of income replacement indemnities for 2003” has effect from 1 January 2003.

Regulation respecting the table of income replacement indemnities for 2003

An Act respecting industrial accidents and occupational diseases
(R.S.Q., c. A-3.001, s. 63)

1. For the purposes of establishing the income replacement indemnity payable from the fifteenth day, the gross income of the worker is taken into consideration up to the maximum yearly insurable earnings of \$53,500 for the year 2003.

2. For the purposes of computing the weighted net income, the family situations shall be determined as follows:

(1) Worker with dependent spouse:

- (a) Worker with spouse;
- (b) Worker with spouse and 1 dependent;
- (c) Worker with spouse and 2 dependents;
- (d) Worker with spouse and 3 dependents;
- (e) Worker with spouse and 4 dependents or more.

(2) Worker with non-dependent spouse:

- (a) Worker without dependent;
- (b) Worker with 1 dependent;
- (c) Worker with 2 dependents;
- (d) Worker with 3 dependents;
- (e) Worker with 4 dependents or more.

(3) Single or single-parent family:

- (a) Worker without dependent;
- (b) Worker with 1 dependent;
- (c) Worker with 2 dependents;
- (d) Worker with 3 dependents;
- (e) Worker with 4 dependents or more.

3. This Regulation comes into force on the fifteenth day following the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.
