An Act respecting the Government and Public Employees Retirement Plan
(R.S.Q., c. R-10)

Recovery of certain administrative expenses and of certain other expenses — Revocation

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (R.S.Q., c. R-18.1), that the Regulation to revoke the Regulation respecting the recovery of certain administrative expenses and of certain other expenses within the framework of the partition and assignment between spouses of benefits accrued under a pension plan, the text of which appears below, may be made by the Conseil du trésor upon the expiry of 45 days following this publication.

The Regulation respecting the recovery of certain administrative expenses and of certain other expenses within the framework of the partition and assignment between spouses of benefits accrued under a pension plan was made by Order in Council 352-91 dated 20 March 1991. The pension committees referred to in sections 164 and 173.1 of the Act respecting the Government and Public Employees Retirement Plan recently reconsidered the advisability of having the CARRA charge fees to calculate and pay the benefits accrued by the member of a pension plan, in the case of a partition of the family patrimony, and recommend the Regulation be revoked, effective retroactively to 1 April 2003, in accordance with the second paragraph of section 158.13 of the Act.

Regulation to revoke the Regulation respecting the recovery of certain administrative expenses and of certain other expenses within the framework of the partition and assignment between spouses of benefits accrued under a pension plan *
