An Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife
(R.S.Q., c. C-61.1)

Classes of aquaculture licenses

Notice is given, by the present, that the “Regulation respecting the classes of aquaculture licenses” for which the text appears below, is adopted by the Société de la faune et des parcs du Québec by resolution N° 03-67 dated January 24, 2003, in conformity with section 54.1 of the Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife.

Regulation respecting the classes of aquaculture licences

An Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife
(R.S.Q., c. C-61.1, s. 54.1)

1. The classes of aquaculture licences referred to in the Regulation respecting aquaculture and the sale of fish made by Order in Council 1302-94 dated 17 August 1994 are the following:

- (1) a licence to operate a breeding pond;
- (2) a licence to operate a fish-tank for baitfish;
- (3) a licence to transport and stock;
- (4) a licence to transport; and
- (5) a licence to extract roe and milt and to transport.

2. A licence to transport and stock and a licence to transport may be issued by facsimile machine, in which case the facsimile shall serve as the licence.

3. A licence to operate a breeding pond shall contain the following information:

- (1) the holder’s name and address;
- (2) the species of fish to be bred;
- (3) the location of the breeding ponds and a description of those facilities; and
- (4) the term and the date of issue of the licence.

4. A licence to operate a fish-tank for baitfish shall contain the following information:

- (1) the holder’s name and address;
- (2) the location of the fish-tanks for baitfish and a description of those facilities; and
- (3) the term and the date of issue of the licence.

5. A licence to extract roe and milt and to transport shall contain the following information:

- (1) the holder’s name and address;
- (2) the species of fish, their sex and size and the maximum number of fish from which the licence holder may extract roe and milt;
- (3) the place of origin and destination of the fish; and
- (4) the date of issue and expiry of the licence.

6. A licence to transport and stock and a licence to transport shall contain the following information:

- (1) the holder’s name and address;
- (2) the species of fish, their size and the maximum number of fish whose transport or stocking is authorized;
- (3) the place of origin and destination of the fish;
- (4) the dates of transport or stocking of the species of fish; and
- (5) the date of issue and expiry of the licence.

7. A licence to operate a breeding pond and a licence to operate a fish-tank for baitfish are valid for one year from 1 April to 31 March.

A licence to extract roe and milt and to transport is valid for a period not exceeding three months from the date of issue.

A licence to transport and stock and a licence to transport expires on the fifteenth day following the date of issue; where several transport or stocking dates are indicated thereon, those licences expire on the ninetieth day following the date of issue.

8. This Regulation replaces the first paragraph of section 9, the second paragraph of section 11 and sections 18 and 22 of the Regulation respecting aquaculture and the sale of fish made by Order in Council 1302-94 dated 17 August 1994.

9. This Regulation comes into force on the fifteenth day following the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.
