An Act respecting municipal territorial organization
(R.S.Q., c. O-9)

Amendment to the letters patent constituting Municipalité régionale de comté de Joliette

WHEREAS Municipalité régionale de comté de Joliette was constituted on 1 January 1982 by letters patent issued under the Act respecting land use planning and development (R.S.Q., c. A-19.1);

WHEREAS, under section 210.39 of the Act respecting municipal territorial organization (R.S.Q., c. O-9), made applicable to the regional county municipality by section 109 of the Act to amend the Act respecting municipal territorial organisation and other legislative provisions (1993, c. 65), the Government may, at the request of the regional county municipality, amend its letters patent with regard to the number of representatives, the number of votes, the power of veto or the majority required for the election of the warden;

WHEREAS the council of Municipalité régionale de comté de Joliette passed resolution 174-11-2004 on 24 November 2004 requesting the Government to amend its letters patent with regard to the number of votes of each municipality on the council of the regional county municipality;

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the letters patent of Municipalité régionale de comté de Joliette;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Regions:

THAT the letters patent constituting Municipalité régionale de comté de Joliette be amended by replacing the third paragraph of the operative part by the following:

“The representative of a municipality on the council of Municipalité régionale de comté de Joliette has one vote for the first 300 inhabitants or fewer in the representative’s municipality and one additional vote for each additional 300 inhabitants.”.
