## Décret 781-2006, 22 août 2006

CONCERNANT l'insaisissabilité d'œuvres d'art et de biens historiques provenant de l'extérieur du Québec

ATTENDU QUE l'article 553.1 du Code de procédure civile (L.R.Q., c. C-25) permet au gouvernement de déclarer insaisissables, pour la période qu'il détermine, les œuvres d'art ou biens historiques qui proviennent de l'extérieur du Québec et y sont exposés publiquement ou sont destinés à l'être, dans la mesure où ces œuvres ou ces biens n'ont pas été à l'origine conçus, produits ou réalisés au Québec ;

ATTENDU QUE le Musée canadien des civilisations présentera, du 30 novembre 2006 au 3 septembre 2007, l'exposition «Maîtres des plaines : Nomades anciens de la Russie et du Canada» ;

ATTENDU QUE les œuvres d'art et biens historiques mentionnés à la liste ci-jointe et exposés publiquement au Québec dans le cadre de cette exposition proviennent de l'extérieur du Québec et n'ont pas été à l'origine conçus, produits ou réalisés au Québec ;

ATTENDU QU'il y a lieu de déclarer l'insaisissabilité des œuvres et biens mentionnés à la liste ci-jointe, de même que toute autre œuvre d'art et tout bien historique qui pourront s'y ajouter dans le cadre de l'exposition «Maîtres des plaines : Nomades anciens de la Russie et du Canada», et ce, à compter de leur date d'arrivée, soit le ou vers le 15 octobre 2006 et jusqu'à leur date de départ, soit le ou vers le 3 octobre 2007 ;

ATTENDU QUE, conformément au troisième alinéa de l'article 553.1 du Code de procédure civile, cette insaisissabilité n'empêche pas l'exécution de jugements rendus pour donner effet à des contrats de services relatifs au transport, à l'entreposage et à l'exposition de ces œuvres d'art et biens historiques et de toute œuvre d'art et tout bien historique qui pourront s'y ajouter dans le cadre de l'exposition «Maîtres des plaines : Nomades anciens de la Russie et du Canada» ;

IL EST ORDONNÉ, en conséquence, sur la recommandation du ministre de la Justice :

QUE les œuvres d'art et biens historiques provenant de l'extérieur du Québec et n'ayant pas été à l'origine conçus, produits ou réalisés au Québec, dont la liste apparaît en annexe, et qui seront exposés du 30 novembre 2006 au 3 septembre 2007, au Musée canadien des civilisations, dans le cadre de l'exposition «Maîtres des plaines : Nomades anciens de la Russie et du Canada», ainsi que toute autre œuvre d'art et tout bien historique qui pourront s'y ajouter et qui n'ont pas été à l'origine conçus, produits ou réalisés au Québec, soient déclarés insaisissables à compter de leur date d'arrivée, soit le ou vers le 15 octobre 2006 ;

QUE cette insaisissabilité demeure en vigueur jusqu'au moment du départ du Québec de ces œuvres d'art et biens historiques, et de toute œuvre d'art et tout bien historique qui pourront s'y ajouter dans le cadre de l'exposition «Maîtres des plaines : Nomades anciens de la Russie et du Canada», soit le ou vers le 3 octobre 2007 ;

QUE le présent décret entre en vigueur à la date de sa publication à la *Gazette officielle du Québec*.
