

Regulation amending the Regulation respecting personalized rates*

An Act respecting industrial accidents and occupational diseases
(R.S.Q., c. A-3.001, s. 454, par. 1, subpar. 7)

1. The Regulation respecting personalized rates is hereby amended by replacing Schedule 1 with the following:

“SCHEDULE 1 (s. 7, 20, 21)

The qualification threshold for the year 2009 is \$1,100.

For the year 2009, the amount used in respect of the calculation in section 20 is \$3,300.

For the year 2009, the amount used in respect of the calculation in section 21 is \$154,000.”

2. This Regulation applies for the 2009 year of assessment.

Table of income replacement indemnities payable under the Act respecting industrial accidents and occupational diseases and of indemnities payable under the Workers' Compensation Act for 2009

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (R.S.Q., c. R-18.1), that the “Regulation respecting the Table of income replacement indemnities payable under the Act respecting industrial accidents and occupational diseases and of indemnities payable under the Workers' Compensation Act for 2009”, the text of which appears below, shall be adopted by the Commission de la santé et de la sécurité du travail upon the expiry of 45 days from the date of publication hereof.

The purpose of the draft regulation is to index this table on the basis of the changes made to income tax payable under the Taxation Act (R.S.Q., c. I-3) and under the Income Tax Act (R.S.C., 1985, c. I, 5th Supp.),

to the employee's premium payable under the Employment Insurance Act (1996, c. 23), to the contribution payable by the worker under the Act respecting the Québec Pension Plan (R.S.Q., c. R-9) and to the contribution payable by the worker under the Act respecting parental insurance (R.S.Q., c. A-29.011).

To date, study of the matter has revealed the following impacts on the public and on businesses directly concerned by those amendments:

— Like any other person earning a salary or wages in 2009, the net income of any person receiving an income replacement indemnity or an indemnity payable under the Workers' Compensation Act shall be adjusted on the basis of amendments to legislation pertaining to taxation, employment insurance, parental insurance and the Québec Pension Plan.
