**Personalized rates
— Amendment**

Notice is hereby given in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (R.S.Q., c. R-18.1) that upon the expiry of 45 days following this publication the “Regulation amending the Regulation respecting personalized rates”, the text of which appears below, may be made adopted by the Commission de la santé et de la sécurité du travail.

This draft Regulation provides for, among other things, amendment of the employer’s qualification threshold in respect of personalized rates for the year 2009 and certain parameters used in calculating the rate.

The amendment for the year 2009 allow for approximately the same number of employers qualifying for personalized rates as in 2008 to be maintained.

Regulation amending the Regulation respecting personalized rates*

An Act respecting industrial accidents and occupational diseases
(R.S.Q., c. A-3.001, s. 454, par. 1, subpar. 7)

1. The Regulation respecting personalized rates is hereby amended by replacing Schedule 1 with the following:

“SCHEDULE 1 (s. 7, 20, 21)

The qualification threshold for the year 2009 is \$1,100.

For the year 2009, the amount used in respect of the calculation in section 20 is \$3,300.

For the year 2009, the amount used in respect of the calculation in section 21 is \$154,000.”

2. This Regulation applies for the 2009 year of assessment.

The purpose of the draft regulation is to index the table of gross annual income from suitable employments for 2009.

To date, study of the matter has revealed no significant impact on the public and on businesses directly concerned by those amendments.
