

3. The Decree is amended by adding the following after section 12.01:

“**12.02.** As of (indicate here the date of the coming into force of this decree), the employee who holds a card as chassis or differential specialist maintains his card and is entitled, depending on the length of his service, to the minimum hourly rates provided for in section 9.01 for the suspension specialist.”.

4. This Decree comes into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.

(R.S.Q., c. S-2.2)

Regulation — Amendment

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (R.S.Q., c. R-18.1), that the Regulation to amend the Regulation under the Public Health Act, appearing below, may be made by the Government on the expiry of 45 days following this publication.

The draft Regulation adds new types of infections to the list of diseases and infections for which the Minister of Health and Social Services compensates, regardless of responsibility, any victim of bodily injury caused by a voluntary vaccination against those infections.

The draft Regulation has no significant impact on enterprises, including small and medium-sized businesses.

Regulation to amend the Regulation under the Public Health Act*

Public Health Act
(R.S.Q., c. S-2.2, s. 137, par. 1)

1. The Regulation under the Public Health Act is amended in section 4 by inserting the following in the list after “pneumococcal infections”:

- “- rotavirus infections
- HPV infections”.

2. This Regulation comes into force on the fifteenth day following the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.

Highway Safety Code
(R.S.Q., c. C-24.2)

Road vehicle registration — Amendment

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (R.S.Q., c. R-18.1), that the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting road vehicle registration, appearing below, may be made by the Government on the expiry of 45 days following this publication.

The draft Regulation proposes to exclude from the definition of “truck” pick-up trucks with a net weight between 3,000 kg and 4,000 kg used by individuals for non-commercial and non-professional purposes.

Individual pick-up truck owners who will have the registration of their pick-up trucks modified in accordance with the proposed measure will see the amounts of their registration fees and insurance contribution decrease respectively by \$296 and \$51 on an annual basis. They will then pay the rate for owners of passenger vehicles, that is, \$104 in registration fees and \$119 in insurance contribution. To that end, they are to obtain a passenger vehicle licence plate. Like every owner of a

passenger vehicle, they will be subject to the \$30 contribution of motorists to public transit in the applicable regions and to an additional fee for large-displacement vehicles. The fee is \$30 for a vehicle with an engine displacement of 4 litres and is increased by \$10 for each additional decilitre, up to a maximum of \$150.

The measure proposed by the draft Regulation has no impact on enterprises.

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting road vehicle registration*

Highway Safety Code
(R.S.Q., c. C-24.2, s. 618, par. 12)

1. The Regulation respecting road vehicle registration is amended by replacing, in section 2, the definition of “truck” by the following:

“truck”: means a road vehicle having a net weight over 3,000 kg, principally designed and equipped for the transportation of goods or of machinery with which it is permanently equipped and goods, with the exception of a two-axle road vehicle, having a net weight of 4,000 kg or less, belonging to a natural person that is not used for commercial or professional purposes, fitted with a separate closed cab and originally having an open truck box and tailgate.

2. This regulation comes into force on 1 July 2009.

Securities Act
(R.S.Q., c. V-1.1)

Securities — Amendments

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (R.S.Q., c. R-18.1), that the Regulation to amend the Securities Regulation, appearing below, may be submitted to the Government, which may approve it with or without amendment, on the expiry of 45 days following this publication.

The draft Regulation introduces consequential amendments into the Securities Regulation following the assent of the Act to amend the Securities Act and other legislative provisions (2006, c. 50). It strikes out from the Securities Regulation the references to the sections of the Securities Act (R.S.Q., c. V-1.1) concerning take-over bids, that were revoked by chapter 50 of the Statutes of 2006. It also eliminates the payment of fees on take-over bids in reliance on an exemption.

The draft Regulation also amends the Securities Regulation in order to ensure compliance with Regulation 62-104 respecting take-over bids and issuer bids approved by Minister's Order 2008-02 dated 22 January 2008.
