### **Professional activities which may be performed by a clinical perfusionist — Amendment**

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the professional activities which may be performed by a clinical perfusionist

WHEREAS, under paragraph *h* of section 94 of the Professional Code (R.S.Q., c. C-26), amended by paragraph 3 of section 62 of chapter 11 of the Statutes of 2008, the board of directors of a professional order may make a regulation to determine, among the professional activities that may be engaged in by members of the order, those that may be engaged in by the persons or categories of persons indicated in the regulation, and the terms and conditions on which such persons may engage in such activities;

WHEREAS, in accordance with paragraph *h* of section 94 of the Professional Code, the board of directors of the Collège des médecins du Québec consulted the Ordre des infirmières et infirmiers du Québec and the Ordre professionnel des inhalothérapeutes du Québec before making the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the professional activities which may be performed by a clinical perfusionist;

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 95 of the Professional Code, amended by section 63 of chapter 11 of the Statutes of 2008, and subject to section 95.2 of the Code, every regulation made by the board of directors of a professional order under the Code or an Act constituting a professional order must be transmitted to the Office des professions du Québec for examination and be submitted, with the recommendation of the Office, to the Government which may approve it with or without amendment;

WHEREAS, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (R.S.Q., c. R-18.1), a draft of the Regulation was published in Part 2 of the *Gazette officielle du Québec* of 23 December 2008 with a notice that it could be submitted to the Government for approval on the expiry of 45 days following that publication;

WHEREAS, in accordance with section 95 of the Professional Code, the Office has examined the Regulation and made its recommendation;

WHEREAS it is expedient to approve the Regulation without amendment;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Justice:

THAT the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the professional activities which may be performed by a clinical perfusionist, attached to this Order in Council, be approved.

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### **Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the professional activities which may be performed by a clinical perfusionist\***

Professional Code  
(R.S.Q., c. C-26, s. 94, par. *h*; 2008, c. 11, s. 62)

**1.** The Regulation respecting the professional activities which may be performed by a clinical perfusionist is amended by replacing “2009” in section 5 by “2010”.

**2.** This Regulation comes into force on the fifteenth day following the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.
