Notice 2009-01 of the Minister of Transport dated 3 June 2009

Highway Safety Code
(R.S.Q., c. C-24.2)

Ville de Blainville — Disallowance

Disallowance of By-law 1330-1 amending By-law 1330 setting speed limits applicable to road vehicles travelling on all roads of the municipality

CONSIDERING that an agreement was entered into on 13 January 2006 by the Minister of Transport and Ville de Blainville under the first paragraph of section 628.1 of the Highway Safety Code (R.S.Q., c. C-24.2);

CONSIDERING that, under the second paragraph of section 628 of the Code, the Minister may disallow a by-law if it may endanger the safety or impair the mobility of persons or goods;

Notice is hereby given that, in accordance with the powers conferred on the Minister under the third paragraph of section 626 and section 628.1 of the Highway Safety Code, the Minister of Transport has disallowed By-law 1330-1 amending By-law 1330 setting speed limits applicable to road vehicles travelling on all roads of the municipality, adopted on 10 March 2009;

The segment of chemin de la Côte-Saint-Louis, between rue de Gatineau and rue Legault, is of a rural nature suitable for speeds above 50 km/h. The establishment of a speed limit of 50 km/h on that road segment, without any accompanying measure, would have a negative impact on the safety of users.

In addition, a speed limit of 50 km/h on that road segment would make possible the traffic of low-speed vehicles moving at less than 40 km/h, which could endanger the safety of users.

The decision of the Minister of Transport was communicated to the authorities of Ville de Blainville on 3 June 2009.
