COMING INTO FORCE of certain provisions of the Act to prevent, combat and punish certain fraudulent practices in the construction industry and make other amendments to the Building Act

WHEREAS the Act to prevent, combat and punish certain fraudulent practices in the construction industry and make other amendments to the Building Act (2011, c. 35) was assented to on 9 December 2011;

WHEREAS section 68 of the Act provides that the provisions of the Act come into force on 9 December 2011, except sections 11 to 13, 22, 29 and 30, which come into force on the date or dates to be set by the Government, sections 42 to 45, which come into force on the same date as that to be set by the Government for the coming into force, respectively, of sections 41, 43, 44 and 46 of chapter 17 of the Statutes of 2011, sections 46 to 55, which come into force on the same date as that to be set by the Government for the coming into force of section 49 of chapter 17 of the Statutes of 2011, and section 60, which comes into force on the same date as that to be set by the Government for the coming into force of section 63 of chapter 17 of the Statutes of 2011;

WHEREAS it is expedient to set 14 December 2011 as the date of coming into force of sections 22, 29 and 30 of the Act;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Labour:

THAT sections 22, 29 and 30 of the Act to prevent, combat and punish certain fraudulent practices in the construction industry and make other amendments to the Building Act (2011, c. 35) come into force on 14 December 2011.
