Toll road infrastructures operated under a public-private partnership agreement — Amendment

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting toll road infrastructures operated under a public-private partnership agreement

WHEREAS, under the second paragraph of section 11 of the Act respecting transport infrastructure partnerships (R.S.Q., c. P-9.001), the Government may, by regulation, exempt any road vehicle or class of road vehicle from the payment of a toll;

WHEREAS, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (R.S.Q., c. R-18.1), a draft of the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting toll road infrastructures operated under a public-private partnership agreement was published in Part 2 of the *Gazette officielle du Québec* of 1 February 2012 with a notice that it could be made by the Government on the expiry of 45 days following that publication;

WHEREAS it is expedient to make the Regulation with amendment;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Transport:

THAT the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting toll road infrastructures operated under a public-private partnership agreement, attached to this Order in Council, be made.

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting toll road infrastructures operated under a public-private partnership agreement

An Act respecting transport infrastructure partnerships
(R.S.Q., c. P-9.001, s. 11, 2nd par.)

1. The Regulation respecting toll road infrastructures operated under a public-private partnership agreement (R.R.Q., c. P-9.001, r. 3) is amended by adding the following after section 2, before section 3:

“**2.1.** The following road vehicles are exempted from payment of the toll for their passages on bridge P-15020 on autoroute 25:

(1) emergency vehicles within the meaning of the Highway Safety Code (R.S.Q., c. C-24.2);

(2) road vehicles for which a registration plate was issued by the Department of National Defence (Canada).

Subparagraph 2 of the first paragraph does not operate to limit the exemption provided for in section 261 of the National Defence Act (R.S.C. 1985, c. N-5).”.

2. Section 3 is amended by striking out paragraph 2.

3. This Regulation comes into force on the fifteenth day following the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*
