

## Draft Regulation

Professional Code  
(chapter C-26)

### Medical technologists — Diplomas giving access to permits — Amendment

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1), that the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the diplomas issued by designated educational institutions which give access to permits or specialist's certificates of professional orders, appearing below, may be made by the Government on the expiry of 45 days following this publication.

The draft Regulation amends section 2.06 of the Regulation respecting the diplomas issued by designated educational institutions which give access to permits or specialist's certificates of professional orders to add a new program. Diploma holders who have completed the program may obtain a medical technologist permit from the Ordre professionnel des technologistes médicaux du Québec.

The draft Regulation has no impact on enterprises, including small and medium-sized businesses.

The draft Regulation will be submitted to the Office des professions du Québec and to the Ordre professionnel des technologistes médicaux du Québec for their opinion. To that end, the Office will seek the opinion of the Order and forward it with its own opinion to the Minister of Justice after consultation with the educational institutions and bodies concerned.

### Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the diplomas issued by designated educational institutions which give access to permits or specialist's certificates of professional orders

Professional Code  
(chapter C-26, s. 184)

**1.** The Regulation respecting the diplomas issued by designated educational institutions which give access to permits or specialist's certificates of professional orders (chapter C-26, r. 2) is amended in section 2.06

(1) by inserting “de” in the French text after “général et professionnel” in the first paragraph;

(2) by replacing in the first paragraph

(a) “Saguenay–Lac-Saint-Jean (Chicoutimi campus)” by “Chicoutimi”;

(b) “Bourchemin (Saint-Hyacinthe campus), Shawinigan” by “Saint-Hyacinthe”;

(c) “and Dawson general and vocational colleges” by “and Outaouais general and vocational colleges, Dawson College and Collège Shawinigan”;

(3) by striking out the second paragraph.

**2.** The second paragraph of section 2.06, struck out by paragraph 3 of section 1 of this Regulation, remains applicable to persons who, (*insert the date of coming into force of this Regulation*), hold the attestation d'études collégiales postsecondaires referred to therein.

**3.** This Regulation comes into force on the fifteenth day following the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.
