An Act respecting off-highway vehicles (chapter V-1.2)

Operation of off-highway vehicles over a portion of chemin Poisson-Blanc under the management of the Minister of Transport — Municipalité de Notre-Dame-du-Laus

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with sections 10, 12 and 13 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1), that the Regulation to authorize the operation of off-highway vehicles over a portion of chemin Poisson-Blanc under the management of the Minister of Transport, appearing below, may be made by the Minister of Transport on the expiry of 20 days following this publication.

The draft Regulation authorizes the operation of motorized all-terrain vehicles and side-by-side vehicles over a portion of chemin Poisson-Blanc in the territory of Municipalité de Notre-Dame-du-Laus.

The operation of motorized all-terrain vehicles is currently allowed on that portion of road until 23 July 2014. The Minister is of the opinion that the urgency of the situation justifies a shorter publication period than the period provided for in the Regulations Act due to the need to authorize again without interruption the operation of certain all-terrain vehicles.

Regulation to authorize the operation of off-highway vehicles over a portion of chemin Poisson-Blanc under the management of the Minister of Transport

An Act respecting off-highway vehicles (chapter V-1.2, s. 11, 2nd par., subpar. 6, and s. 47)

I. The operation of off-highway vehicles, referred to in subparagraph 2 of the first paragraph of section 1 of the Act respecting off-highway vehicles (chapter V-1.2) and in the Ministerial Order concerning the Pilot project concerning side-by-side vehicles (chapter V-1.2, r. 4), is authorized from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. over a portion of chemin Poisson-Blanc (27501-01), located in the territory of Municipalité de Notre-Dame-du-Laus (79005) and over a distance of 5.9 km, namely, from chaining 3 + 745 to chaining 9 + 760.

2. This Regulation comes into force on 23 July 2014 and ceases to have effect on 1 August 2019.

Strobe lights on road vehicles used for the transportation of school children

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1), that the Regulation respecting the addition and use of strobe lights on road vehicles used for the transportation of school children, appearing below, may be made by the Minister of Transport on the expiry of 45 days following this publication.

The draft Regulation temporarily authorizes, on certain conditions, the addition of strobe lights on road vehicles covered by the Regulation respecting road vehicles used for the transportation of school children (chapter T-12, r. 17).

The draft Regulation has no particular impact on enterprises, including small and medium-sized businesses.

Regulation respecting the addition and use of strobe lights on road vehicles used for the transportation of school children

Highway Safety Code (chapter C-24.2, s. 633.2)

Transport Act (chapter T-12, s. 4.2)

I. A white strobe light having a range of 360° may be added on a road vehicle covered by the Regulation respecting road vehicles used for the transportation of school children (chapter T-12, r. 17).

The light is installed in the last third of the roof of the vehicle and centred on its width.

2. The strobe light may only be used when the vehicle is in the territory of the regional county municipalities of La Côte-de-Beaupré and Charlevoix and for the transportation of any person under 18 years of age.

3. The application of the provisions of section 239 of the Highway Safety Code (chapter C-24.2) is suspended when it prohibits a road vehicle from having a strobe light in accordance with section 1.

4. This Regulation comes into force on (*insert the date of publication in the Gazette officielle du Québec*) and ceases to have effect on 22 June 2016.
