An Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1)

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting trapping and the fur trade

THE MINISTER OF FORESTS, WILDLIFE AND PARKS,

CONSIDERING subparagraph 4 of the third paragraph of section 56 of the Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1), which provides, in particular, that the Minister may make regulations to determine the types of traps which may be used for trapping;

CONSIDERING the first paragraph of section 164 of the Act, which provides, in particular, that a regulation made under section 56 of the Act is not subject to the publication requirements set out in section 8 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1);

CONSIDERING the making of the Regulation respecting trapping and the fur trade (chapter C-61.1, r. 21);

CONSIDERING that it is expedient to amend certain provisions of the Regulation;

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

The Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting trapping and the fur trade, attached hereto, is hereby made;

The Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting trapping and the fur trade comes into force on the fifteenth day following the date of publication of this Order in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting trapping and the fur trade

An Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1, s. 56)

- **1.** Schedule II to the Regulation respecting trapping and the fur trade (chapter C-61.1, r. 21) is amended:
- (1) by inserting "(Note 2)" in Column I "Species" after "Ermine" and "River otter";
- (2) by striking out ", 8" in Column II "Implement type" for the Canadian lynx;
- (3) by inserting "ermine, river otter, Canadian lynx," in Note 2 after "beaver".
- **2.** This Regulation comes into force on the fifteenth day following the date of its publication in the *Gazette* officielle du Ouébec.
