Order number AM 2016-006 of the Minister of Forests, Wildlife and Parks dated 14 July 2016

CONCERNING the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the scale of fees and duties related to the development of wildlife

THE MINISTER OF FORESTS, WILDLIFE AND PARKS,

CONSIDERING subparagraph 4 of the first paragraph of section 163 of the Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (R.S.Q., c. C-61.1), which provides that the Minister may make regulations setting the fees or maximum fees payable for the issue, replacement, renewal or transfer of a licence, certificate, authorization or lease, as well as the fees or maximum fees payable for late payments or for administrative services involved in the processing of applications;

CONSIDERING the making of the Regulation respecting the scale of fees and duties related to the development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1, r. 32);

CONSIDERING that, under section 12 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1), a proposed regulation may be made without having been published if the authority making it is of the opinion that the urgency of the situation requires it;

CONSIDERING that, under section 18 of that Act, a regulation may come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec* where the authority that has made it is of the opinion that the urgency of the situation requires it;

CONSIDERING that, under sections 13 and 18 of that Act, the reason justifying the absence of prior publication and such coming into force must be published with the regulation;

CONSIDERING that, in the opinion of the Minister of Forests, Wildlife and Parks, the urgency due to the following circumstances justifies the absence of prior publication and such coming into force for the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the scale of fees and duties related to the development of wildlife: — the amendments provided for in the Regulation attached to this Minister's Order must come into force no later than 27 July 2016 because caribou hunting begins on 15 August 2016 and hunting licences must be made available to users before that date;

CONSIDERING that it is expedient to make the Regulation;

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

The Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the scale of fees and duties related to the development of wildlife, attached hereto, is hereby made.

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the scale of fees and duties related to the development of wildlife

An Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1, s. 163, 1st par., subpar. 4)

1. The Regulation respecting the scale of fees and duties related to the development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1, r. 32) is amended in Schedule:

(1) by replacing section 1 by the following:

"1	(a)	Caribou valid for the part of Area 22 shown on the plan in Schedule XII i. resident	\$40.08
	(b)	Caribou valid for the part of Area 22 shown on the plan in Schedule XVII i. resident ii. non-resident iii. non-resident Canadian	\$40.08 \$190.14 \$81.46
	(c)	Caribou valid for Area 23 except the southern part shown on the plan in Schedule XVIII and except the eastern part shown on the plan in Schedule CC i. resident ii. non-resident iii. non-resident Canadian	\$40.08 \$190.14 \$81.46

(2) by adding the following at the end:

"In this Schedule, area numbers refer to the areas established by the Regulation respecting fishing and hunting areas (chapter C-61.1, r. 34) and schedule numbers refer to the Schedules to the Regulation respecting hunting (chapter C-61.1, r. 12).".

2. Schedule VI is amended by adding the following at the end:

"In this Schedule, area numbers refer to the areas established by the Regulation respecting fishing and hunting areas (chapter C-61.1, r. 34) and schedule numbers refer to the Schedules to the Regulation respecting hunting (chapter C-61.1, r. 12).".

3. This Regulation comes into force on the day of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.
