## Solid waste removal – Montréal —Amendment

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with section 5 of the Act respecting collective agreement decrees (chapter D-2), that the Minister responsible for Labour has received an application from the contracting parties to amend the Decree respecting solid waste removal in the Montréal region (chapter D-2, r. 5) and that, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1), the draft Decree to amend the Decree respecting solid waste removal in the Montréal region, appearing below, may be made by the Government on the expiry of 45 days following this publication.

The draft Decree mainly increases the minimum hourly wages provided for in the Decree.

Study of the matter has shown that the amendments will have a negligible impact on small and medium-sized businesses.

## Decree to amend the Decree respecting solid waste removal in the Montréal region

An Act respecting collective agreement decrees (chapter D-2, ss. 4 and 6.1)

**1.** The Decree respecting solid waste removal in the Montréal region (chapter D-2, r. 5) is amended by replacing section 6.01 by the following:

"6.01. The minimum hourly wage is the following:
