An Act respecting prescription drug insurance
(chapter A-29.01)

Benefits authorized for pharmacists — Amendment

CONCERNING the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting benefits authorized for pharmacists

WHEREAS, pursuant to the third paragraph of section 22 of the Act respecting prescription drug insurance (chapter A-29.01), if, after an investigation, the Board believes that pharmaceutical services or medications, for which payment is claimed by a pharmacist or for which he received payment in the preceding 60 months, have been the object of rebates, gratuities or other benefits not authorized by regulation of the Government to this pharmacist, it may deduct an amount corresponding to the value of these benefits from the payment for those services or medications or obtain the reimbursement of that amount by way of compensation or otherwise, as the case may be;

WHEREAS it is expedient to modify the limit of the professional allowances authorized under the Regulation respecting benefits authorized for pharmacists (chapter A-29.01, r. 1);

WHEREAS, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1), a draft of the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting benefits authorized for pharmacists was published in Part 2 of the *Gazette officielle du Québec* on 19 July 2017, with notice that it could be enacted by the Government upon expiry of the 45-day period following that publication;

WHEREAS, it is expedient to enact that Regulation without any amendments;

IT IS ORDERED, therefore, on the recommendation of the Minister of Health and Social Services:

THAT the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting benefits authorized for pharmacists, attached to this Order in Council, be enacted.

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting benefits authorized for pharmacists

An Act respecting prescription drug insurance
(chapter A-29.01, s. 22, 3rd para.)

1. The Regulation respecting benefits authorized for pharmacists (chapter A-29.01, r. 1) is amended, in the third paragraph of section 2, by deleting “However, this percentage will be 25% for a period of 6 months effective from 28 April 2016 and 30% for the following 3 months. After these last 3 months, no limit will apply for a period of 2 years and 3 months.”.

2. This Regulation comes into force on the 15th day following the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.

Regulation respecting the applicable percentages for the purposes of levying the assessment on employers personally liable for the payment of benefits for 2018

An Act respecting industrial accidents and occupational diseases
(chapter A-3.001, s. 454, par. 1, subpar. 16)

1. The purpose of this regulation is to determine the applicable percentages for the purposes of levying the assessment on employers personally liable for the payment of benefits to defray the costs for the administration of Chapter X of the Act respecting industrial accidents and occupational diseases (chapter A-3.001) under Section 343 of said act.

2. The applicable percentages for employers under federal jurisdiction are:

(1) 30.2% when the benefits are paid by the Commission;

(2) 28.2% when the benefits are paid by the employer.

3. The applicable percentages for employers under provincial jurisdiction are:

(1) 53.9% when the benefits are paid by the Commission;

(2) 51.9% when the benefits are paid by the employer.

4. This regulation applies to the 2018 assessment year.
