(2) by replacing “Series” in paragraph 2 by “DCS-7517 by D-Link Corporation or D-Link Canada inc., or Series”.

General and Vocational Colleges Act
(chapter C-29)

CONCERNING the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting certain conditions of employment of senior executives of general and vocational colleges

THE MINISTER RESPONSIBLE FOR HIGHER EDUCATION,

WHEREAS in and by section 18.1 of the General and Vocational Colleges Act (chapter C-29);

WHEREAS the Regulation respecting certain conditions of employment of senior executives of general and vocational colleges was made by the Minister’s Order dated 17 June 2005 approved by the Conseil du trésor on 21 June 2005 (C.T. 202573) and as amended;

WHEREAS it is expedient to amend the current Regulation and to make the Regulation attached hereto;

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 18.1 of the General and Vocational Colleges Act, the Conseil du trésor has given its authorization;

WHEREAS the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1) does not apply to such a Regulation;

ORDERS THAT:

The Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting certain conditions of employment of senior executives of general and vocational colleges, herewith attached, be made.

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting certain conditions of employment of senior executives of general and vocational colleges¹

General and Vocational Colleges Act
(chapter C-29, s. 18.1)

1. Section 22 of the Regulation respecting certain conditions of employment of senior executives of general and vocational colleges is replaced by the following:

“22. A senior executive who, at the college’s request, temporarily holds, in addition to his usual position, another full-time senior or senior executive position for a period of at least two months, shall receive, for that entire period, additional remuneration equal to 10% of his salary.

A college may also distribute the inherent duties of the position among the senior executives. The senior executives concerned must perform other duties, in addition to their usual duties, for a period of two months or more. In such case, the total additional remuneration allocated among the senior executives cannot exceed 10% of the maximum of the salary class of the shared position held temporarily. The college's decision to split the duties of the position among several senior executives shall not be subject to any recourse process. The same applies to the allocation of percentage of remuneration among the senior executives concerned as determined by the college.

The additional remuneration shall be paid as a lump sum in accordance with the same procedures as those pertaining to the payment of salary until dual employment ceases.”

2. Section 2 of Schedule II of the Regulation is replaced by the following:
