Notice is hereby given, in accordance with section 5 of the Act respecting collective agreement decrees (chapter D-2), that the Minister responsible for Labour was petitioned by the contracting parties to amend the Decree respecting the automotive services industry in the Drummond and the Mauricie regions (chapter D-2, r. 8) and that, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1), the Decree to amend the Decree respecting the automotive services industry in the Drummond and the Mauricie regions, appearing below, may be made by the Government on the expiry of 45 days following this publication.

The draft Decree increases the minimum hourly wage rates provided for in the Decree.

Decree to amend the Decree respecting the automotive services industry in the Drummond and the Mauricie regions

An Act respecting collective agreement decrees (chapter D-2, ss. 4 and 6.1)

1. The Decree respecting the automotive services industry in the Drummond and the Mauricie regions (chapter D-2, r. 8) is amended by replacing section 9.01 by the following:

"9.01. The minimum hourly wage rates are the following:

Note 1: The minimum wage rate not provided for the trades of messenger, washer and pump attendant corresponds to the rate of the minimum wage payable to an employee, in accordance with section 3 of the Regulation respecting labour standards (chapter N-1.1, r. 3), increased by \$0.25 per hour as of the date of adjustment of the minimum wage rate."

- **2.** Section 12.01 is amended by replacing "31 December 2018" by "[insert the date that occurs 36 months after the date of coming into force of this Decree]" and by replacing "June 2018" and "June", respectively, by "[insert the month and year that precedes by 6 months the date that occurs 36 months after the date of coming into force of this Decree]" and "[insert the month that precedes by 6 months the date that occurs 36 months after the date of coming into force of this Decree]", with the necessary modifications.
- **3.** This Decree comes into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.

Draft Regulation

Highway Safety Code (chapter C-24.2)

Motorcycles and mopeds —Sound emission control

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with section 10 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1) and section 212 of the Act to amend the Highway Safety Code and other provisions (2018, chapter 7), that the Regulation respecting the sound emission control produced by the exhaust system of motorcycles and mopeds, appearing below, may be made by the Government on the expiry of 15 days following this publication.

The draft Regulation is proposed following amendments made to the Highway Safety Code (chapter C-24.2) by the Act to amend the Highway Safety Code and other provisions, assented to on 18 April 2018. The draft Regulation sets the maximum sound emission values that may be produced by a motorcycle's or moped's exhaust system and prescribes the measurement methods and technical standards of sound level meters and other instruments used to measure them.
