Draft Regulation

An Act respecting off-highway vehicles
(chapter V-1.2)

Authorize the operation of certain off-highway vehicles

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1), that the Regulation authorizing the operation of certain off-highway vehicles, appearing below, may be made by the Minister on the expiry of 45 days following this publication.

The draft Regulation allows the operation of off-highway vehicles equipped with an engine or motor that is not mentioned in section 33.1 of the Act respecting off-highway vehicles (chapter V-1.2), which comes into force on 1 January 2020.

Regulation authorizing the operation of certain off-highway vehicles

An Act respecting off-highway vehicles
(chapter V-1.2, s. 47, 1st par., subpar. 5)

1. In addition to the off-highway vehicles mentioned in section 33.1 of the Act respecting off-highway vehicles (chapter V-1.2), off-highway vehicles equipped with the following engines or motor are authorized to be operated in the places listed in paragraphs 1 to 4 of section 12.1 of the Act:

- (1) a two-stroke engine;
- (2) an electric motor;
- (3) a hybrid engine.

2. This Regulation comes into force on the fifteenth day following the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.
