An Act respecting health services and social services for Cree Native persons (chapter S-5)

An Act respecting health services and social services (chapter S-4.2)

Contribution of users of health and social services institutions and users taken in charge by family-type resources and intermediate resources — Amendment

Notice is hereby given, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1) and the third paragraph of section 173 of the Act respecting health services and social services for Cree Native persons (chapter S-5), that the Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the application of the Act respecting health services and social services for Cree Native persons, appearing below, may be made by the Government on the expiry of 60 days following this publication.

The draft Regulation provides for the increase, in addition to the annual indexation, of the personal expense allowance of users of full age sheltered in health and social services institutions and users of full age taken in charge by intermediate resources or family-type resources for 2021 and 2022.

There is no impact on enterprises, including small and medium-sized businesses.

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the application of the Act respecting health services and social services for Cree Native persons

An Act respecting health services and social services for Cree Native persons (chapter S-5, s. 161)

An Act respecting health services and social services (chapter S-4.2, s. 512, 2nd par.)

1. On 1 January 2021 and 2022, the personal expense allowance provided for in subparagraph *b* of the first paragraph of section 375 of the Regulation respecting the application of the Act respecting health services and social services for Cree Native persons (chapter S-5, r. 1) is increased by \$10 in addition to the increase resulting from the indexation and the rounding off provided for in the second paragraph of that section.

2. This Regulation comes into force on the fifteenth day following the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.
