Order 2021-021 of the Minister of Forests, Wildlife and Parks dated 12 October 2021

Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1)

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting fishing licences

THE MINISTER OF FORESTS, WILDLIFE AND PARKS,

CONSIDERING subparagraph 3 of the first paragraph of section 163 of the Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1), which provides that the Minister may make regulations establishing the requirements that a holder of a licence, certificate or authorization must satisfy;

CONSIDERING the first paragraph of section 164 of the Act, which provides in particular that a regulation made under subparagraphs 1 to 3 of the first paragraph of section 163 of the Act is not subject to the publication requirements set out in section 8 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1);

CONSIDERING the making of the Regulation respecting fishing licences (chapter C-61.1, r. 20.2);

CONSIDERING that it is expedient to amend the Regulation;

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

The Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting fishing licences, attached to this Order, is hereby made.

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting fishing licences

1. The Regulation respecting fishing licences (chapter C-61.1, r. 20.2) is amended by revoking sections 5 and 6.

2. This Regulation comes into force on 1 April 2022.

Order 2021-21 of the Minister of Transport dated 12 October 2021

Highway Safety Code (chapter C-24.2)

Suspension of the prohibition from operating an off-highway vehicle or a maintenance vehicle referred to in the Act respecting off-highway vehicles (chapter V-1.3) on which a tire is equipped with studs, other than ice screws, from 15 November 2021 to 1 May 2022

THE MINISTER OF TRANSPORT,

CONSIDERING section 633.2 of the Highway Safety Code (chapter C-24.2), which provides that the Minister of Transport may, by order and after consultation with the Société de l'assurance automobile du Québec, suspend the application of a provision of the Code or the regulations for the period specified by the Minister, if the Minister considers that it is in the interest of the public and is not likely to compromise highway safety;

CONSIDERING that section 633.2 of the Code provides that the publication requirement set out in section 8 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1) does not apply to an order made under section 633.2;

CONSIDERING the first paragraph of section 441 of the Highway Safety Code (chapter C-24.2), which provides that no person may drive a road vehicle on which a tire is equipped with non-skid studs or with any other device that may damage the roadway;
