#### Order 2022-017 of the Minister of Forests, Wildlife and Parks dated 23 June 2022

Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife  
(chapter C-61.1)

Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the scale of fees and duties related to the development of wildlife

THE MINISTER OF FORESTS, WILDLIFE AND PARKS,

CONSIDERING subparagraph 5.1 of the first paragraph of section 163 of the Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1), which provides that the Minister of Forests, Wildlife and Parks may make regulations setting the fees payable for the registration of animals or fish;

CONSIDERING the making of the Regulation respecting the scale of fees and duties related to the development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1, r. 32);

CONSIDERING that, in accordance with sections 10 and 11 of the Regulations Act (chapter R-18.1), a draft Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the scale of fees and duties related to the development of wildlife was published in Part 2 of the *Gazette officielle du Québec* of 20 April 2022 with a notice that it could be made on the expiry of 45 days following that publication;

CONSIDERING that it is expedient to make the Regulation without amendment;

ORDERS AS FOLLOWS:

The Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the scale of fees and duties related to the development of wildlife, attached to this Order, is hereby made.

#### Regulation to amend the Regulation respecting the scale of fees and duties related to the development of wildlife

Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife  
(chapter C-61.1, s. 163, 1st par., subpar. 5.1)

**1.** The Regulation respecting the scale of fees and duties related to the development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1, r. 32) is amended by inserting the following after the heading of Division VI.1:

“**14.1.** The fees payable for the registration of white-tailed deer, moose, black bear or wild turkey with the person, partnership or association that the Minister has authorized under section 56.1 of the Act respecting the conservation and development of wildlife (chapter C-61.1) are \$7.39.”

**2.** This Regulation comes into force on the fifteenth day following the date of its publication in the *Gazette officielle du Québec*.
